- ♦ 1874 : The East India Company was dissolved.
- ♦ 1930 : India's first deluxe train Deccan Queen ran between Bombay VT to Pune.

Current Affairs Related to 1 June

- According to the State Bank of India's research paper Ecowrap, India's GDP growth rate is estimated to be between 8.2 to 85 percent in the Q4FY22. Uncertainties abound in GDP estimates, as normal quarterly data adjustments are hard to fathom, but research by SBI's Department of Economic Research predicts it will hit the 3 to 3.5 per cent mark.
- Famous singer Neyveli and. Santhanagopalan and Mridangam player Thiruvarur Bakthavatsalam have been selected for the Sangeet Kalanidhi Award for 2020 and 2021 respectively. Chief Minister MK Stalin will present the awards to the winners on December 15, 2022. The Musicologist Award for 2022 went to V. Premlata. The TTK Award for 2020 was given to singer Thamarkkad Govindan Namboothiri. The idea of ??the prize was conceived in 1942.
- Federation of Indian Export Organizations has launched a first of its kind online marketplace for Indian exporters and overseas buyers. Marketplace-Indian Business Portal- will act as a B2B digital marketplace to help Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises exporters, artisans and farmers to identify new markets for their products and increase their sales globally.
- ♦ HDFC Securities has launched HDFC Money, a robo-advisory investment platform that will offer mutual fund schemes and other financial products without the need for a demat account. Apart from mutual funds, one can manage other aspects of finance such as accessing, managing and tracking portfolios, launching target planning, creating insurance plans, generating e-wills and managing or filing taxes.
- ♦ Bollywood actor Nawazuddin Siddiqui has been honored with an international award for his contribution to cinema. At the prestigious French Riviera Film Festival, Emmy Award-winning American actor Vincent de Paul honored Siddiqui.

- The government has made import registration mandatory from October 1 under the paper import monitoring system. Import policy of major paper products has been amended. A notification to this effect has been issued by the DGFT. Newsprint, handmade paper, wallpaper base, duplicating paper, coated paper, parchment paper, carbon paper, uncoated paper, litho and offset paper, tissue paper, wall paper, envelopes, toilet paper, cartons, account books, labels, bobbins, and others Paper products are covered by this order. This policy will be applicable to all incoming imports.
- The United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change has issued a warning of an impending crisis. Climate change has triggered a code red for humanity, which requires immediate action. This dilemma is inextricably linked to food systems. Climate change has already begun to reduce agricultural production and disrupt supply chains in many countries, particularly in the poorer world, straining livelihoods and threatening significant increases in hunger and malnutrition, leading to adaptation Efforts have been made important.
- Text to Tokyo bronze medalist, IBA Lovlina Borgohain. was elected as the Chairman of the Athlete's Committee. The International Boxing Association announced that Indian boxer and Tokyo Olympic bronze medalist Lovlina Borgohain has garnered the most votes during the election held at the 2022 Women's World Championships, thus serving as the Chairperson and a voting member on the Board of Directors of the Athletes Committee of the IBA. as selected.
- The sela macaque, a new species of Old World monkey, was geographically separated from the Arunachal macaque by the Sela, an eastern Himalayan pass located at an altitude of 13,700 ft. The Science Primate from Sella Macaque Nai was identified and analyzed by a team of experts from the Zoological Survey of India and the University of Calcutta. Their study is published in the latest edition of Molecular Phylogenetics and Evolution.
