Current Affairs Related to 12th April

- An Animation, Visual Effects Gaming and Comics Promotion Working Group has been set up by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. The task force, which will be headed by the second secretary. Will prepare its first action plan within 90 days. Industry, academia and state governments are all represented. The organization will recommend a national curricular framework for undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD courses in areas related to a national AVGC, and collaborate with academic institutions, vocational training centers and industry to support skilling programmes.
- Arya.AG, the Integrated Grain Commerce Forum that has joined the United Nations Global Compact India, is voluntarily adhering to the Universal Sustainability Principles and taking action to support the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. The United Nations Global Compact is an evolving framework of corporate governance-driven sustainability, which forces members to conduct business according to ten principles. n addition, members should take steps to achieve the SDGs by 2030. Presently there are more than 550 organizations which are members of India Network, UN GCNI.
- The tech firm has made 83 launches in five years, what the company claims is the largest commercial launch vehicle purchase in history. Arianespace, Blue Origin and United Launch Alliance have agreed to deploy the majority of Amazon's Project Kuiper satellites, which aim to provide high-speed, low-latency broadband to a variety of customers around the world.
- The six-member Monetary Policy Committee voted unanimously to keep the repo rate unchanged at 4 per cent. The MPC committee kept the reverse repo rate unchanged at 3.35 per cent as Russia's invasion of Ukraine exacerbated the rise in inflation. The Monetary Policy Committee of the Reserve Bank of India, headed by Reserve Bank of India Governor Shaktikanta Das, kept the repo rate unchanged for the 11th time in a row.

- According to the announcement issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, now all adults can be given a booster dose of Kovid-19. According to this, all persons above the age of 18 years will be able to get the Bpk.19 vaccine. All those who are above 18 years of age and who have completed 9 months of taking the second dose will be eligible for this dosage.
- In the history of the International Booker Prize, the novel Tomb of Sand by Geetanjali Shree has become the first Hindi language novel to be selected for the prestigious literary award. The novel has been translated into English by Daisy Rockwell. The Tomb of Sand book will compete with five other novels from around the world. The literary prize comes with a cash prize of £50,000, split equally between the author and the translator.
- In a significant development, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited and Israel Aerospace Industry have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to convert civilian passenger aircraft into multi-mission tanker transport aircraft in India. The Indian Air Force has been looking to purchase new mid air refuelers for some time.
 - The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India has contributed an amount of USD 72,124 to the UNESCO Fund for Doping Elimination in Sports 2022. This is twice the amount of the minimum agreed value. In accordance with the resolution of the 7COP held in Paris between 29-31 September 2019, the State Parties agreed to contribute 1% of their respective countries' regular budgets to UNESCO to the Fund for the Elimination of Doping in Sport.
- A photograph by Canadian photographer Amber Bracken titled Kamloops Residential School has won the 2022 World Press Photo of the Year award. Photo shows children's clothes hanging on crosses in memory of more than two hundred children who died of abuse, neglect and disease at Kamloops Indian Residential School in British Columbia.


