Current Affairs Related to 19th April

- ♦ Odisha Chief Minister Patnaik unveiled the people of the FIH Men's Hockey World Cup 2023 at the Kalinga Stadium in the capital Bhubaneswar. The prestigious quadrangular tournament to be held in the cities of Bhubaneswar and Rourkela is scheduled from January 13 to 29. Hockey India and its official partner Odisha will host this mega tournament for the second time in a row in the country after 2018.
- ♦ Covid-19 detection device was tested from breath samples. It has been granted emergency use by the Food and Drug Administration. This device has been named as Inspectlr Covid-19 Breathalyzer. This device can give its result in less than three minutes. The device was found to be 91.2 percent accurate in identifying positive samples and 99.3 percent in identifying negative samples. It can be used in doctor's offices, hospitals and mobile testing centers. This device will be used under the supervision of a licensed health care institution.
- New Zealand announced awards for men and women cricketers. New Zealand pacer Trent Boult and White Ferns captain Sophie Devine were named T20 International Player of the Year at the recently announced New Zealand Cricket Awards 2022.
- ♦ Eminent Indian economist and political commentator, Prabhat Patnaik has been selected for the Malcolm Adisesia Prize 2022. The award is given annually to an outstanding social scientist selected from nominations received by a specially constituted National Jury by the Malcolm and Elizabeth Adisesia Trust. The award consists of a citation and prize money of Rs 2 lakh. Dr. Patnaik has taught at the Center for Economic Studies and Planning, School of Social Science at Jawaharlal Nehru University in New Delhi. And has been the Deputy Chairman of Kerala State Planning Board.
- ♦ The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has developed a portal named e-DAR means (e-

- detailed accident report). This web portal has been prepared by the government in consultation with the insurance companies. This will be an extension and e-version of iRAD the letter. It will provide instant information on road accidents. It will also help in expediting accident compensation claims
- Kotak Mahindra Bank has launched Kotak FYN. It is a new enterprise platform specially designed for Business Banking and Corporate clients. The customers of the Bank can access the Portal for carrying out all business and service transactions. According to a press release, the Kotak FYN portal will have several other services, including account services, payments and collections, by the fourth quarter of 2022.
- The India Meteorological Department has released its long-term forecast for the year 2022, which states that the monsoon is likely to be normal for the fourth consecutive year in the country. While forecasting a normal south-west monsoon for this year, the IMD has also revised the definition of average rainfall. Each year the IMD issues the forecast in two phases: first in April and second in the last week of May, it is a more detailed forecast that provides information related to the monsoon in the country.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi, through video conferencing, inaugurated a 200-bed KK at Bhuj in Kutch district of Gujarat. Patel Super Specialty Hospital dedicated to the nation. This hospital is built by Shree Kachhi Leva Patel Samaj of Bhuj. This hospital is the first charitable super specialty hospital in Kutch region. It will guarantee quality medical treatment to the people of Kutch, including lakhs of soldiers, military personnel and businessmen. This initiative is in line with the central government's policy of setting up at least one medical college in every district of the country so that India can get a record number of doctors in the next 10 years.
