History of May 2

- 1949: The trial of Mahatma Gandhi's assassination case began.
- 1952: The world's first jet aircraft, the De Havilland Comet 1 made its maiden flight from London to Johannesburg.
- ◆ 1968 : Public Provident Fund Act approved in Lok Sabha.
- ♦ 1959 : First thermoplastic plant opened in Risra.
- ▶ 1968 : Lok Sabha passes Public Provident Fund Bill
- ♦ 1929: Vishnu Kant Shastri, an Indian politician and litterateur, was born.

Current Affairs Related to 2th May

- Agra in Uttar Pradesh has become the first city in the country to have vacuum based sewer system. These vacuums will be used in public places. Agra Smart City officials told the media that the municipal corporation has connected 240 homes near the Taj Mahal with vacuum-based sewers, where conventional sewer systems cannot be used. All the rooms are equipped with Geographic Information System (GIS) based sensors, which will help to pinpoint the area and problem of the room.
- The Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology launched the RISE-V Digital India Initiative. Its aim is to enable India to manufacture future generation microprocessors for the world. So that India can achieve the edge in commercial silicon and design manufacturing by December 2023. This program will promote semiconductor startups in India. It is being considered as an important step towards making India a semiconductor nation and a self-reliant India. The DIR-V will promote partnerships between startups, academia and multinationals.
- The National Association of Software and Services Companies has announced the appointment of Krishnan Ramanujam, President, Enterprise Growth Group at Tata Consultancy Services, as its President for 2022.23. Ramanujam will succeed Rekha M. Menon, President and Senior Managing Director of Accenture India in this role. NASSCOM also announced the appointment of Anant Maheshwari, President, Microsoft India, as its Vice President for the year 2022.23.
- ♦ Netflix India has released a series/series of short videos under an initiative called Azadi Ki Amrit Kahaniyan in association with the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. The role of women has been highlighted in this series. As part of the wider partnership, the global OTT platform will

- also organize workshops and masterclasses for skill development of Indian filmmakers.
- An important effort of the Planning Department of Meghalaya, the e-Proposal system has been awarded the World Summit Award 2022 on Information Society Quorum. It is a prestigious United Nations award. The e-offer system is a part of Meghalaya Enterprise Architecture.
- The Union Cabinet approved the Kwar Hydroelectric Project in Jammu and Kashmir. The project will be implemented by the Chenab Valley Power Projects Ltd. The project is expected to be commissioned within 54 months. Its construction activities will provide direct and indirect employment to about 2500 people. It will be built on the Chenabriver in Kishtwar district of Jammu and Kashmir. It is a 540 MW project. An investment of Rs 4526.12 crore has been approved for this project.
- ♦ The results of the Times Higher Education Impact Ranking 2022 have been declared. The fourth edition of this ranking was published in this year (2022). This ranking includes 1,406 universities from 106 countries/regions. The Impact Ranking is the only ranking that assesses universities in the context of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals.
- ♦ A 30-member Indian contingent participated in the 34th edition of Asian Wrestling Championship 2022 held in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. Indian wrestlers won a total of 17 medals, including 1 gold, 5 silver and 11 bronze medals. Gold medalist Ravi Kumar Dahiya won in men's 57kg freestyle category.
- Tata Sons Executive Chairman N. Chandrasekaran has formally taken over as the Chairman of Tata Digital. Tata's digital strategy is currently led by its CEO Prateek Pal and Cultfit founder Mukesh Bansal. Chandrasekaran's formal appointment assumes significance in view of his future plans to raise funds from outside investors.
