History of April 25

- ♦ 1957: The sodium nuclear reactor was operated experimentally for the first time.

Current Affairs Related to 25th April

- Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways and AYUSH Sarbananda Sonowal said that the first Incredible India International Cruise Conference-2022 will be held in Mumbai. The two-day event in Mumbai is being organized by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Mumbai Port Authority and Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry. The Minister mentioned during a press conference in Mumbai that the Indian cruise market has the potential to grow tenfold in the next decade owing to the increasing demand and disposable income.
- Ajay Kumar Sood, a member of the Prime Minister's Science, Technology and Innovation Advisory Council, has been appointed to the post for a period of three years, replacing renowned biologist K Vijayaraghavan. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of Sood as the Principal Scientific Adviser to the government. The objective of the Office of PSA is to provide practical and objective guidance to the Prime Minister and the Cabinet on matters relating to science, technology and innovation with a focus on the application of science and technology in critical infrastructure, economic and social sectors in partnership with government departments, institutions and industry. is to provide advice.
- The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying will set up a Seaweed/Seaweed Park in Tamil Nadu to improve the livelihood of fishermen. Tamil Nadu has been asked to select a Special Economic Zone for the cultivation of seaweed.
- Manappuram Finance Limited was fined Rs 17.63 lakh for failing to comply with Know Your Customer and Prepaid Payment Instruments Regulations by the Reserve Bank of India. Penalty of Rs.17,63,965 on Manappuram Finance Limited for complying with certain provisions of the Master Direction dated October 11, 2017 on Issuance and Operation of Prepaid Payment Products by the Reserve Bank of India and for failing to comply with the Master Direction in the Know Your Cus-

- tomer instruction dated February 25, 2016 has been imposed.
- In a first of its kind initiative, the second edition of Khelo India University Games to be held in the technical capital Bengaluru will have its own mobile application. This app has been developed by the Department of Youth Empowerment and Sports and hosted by Jain Honorary University. Khelo India Uni Games 2021 is starting from 24th April on mobile app. Il the information related to this prestigious competition will be available in one place. The prestigious Games which will be India's first largest mass-participation sporting event after the pandemic, will see over 4500 participants representing around 189 universities vie for the top honors in 20 disciplines.
- India Post Payments Bank has launched an initiative called FinCluvation as part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Indian Independence. FinCluvation is a joint initiative to collaborate with the fintech startup community to co-create and innovate solutions for financial inclusion. Finclution will be a permanent platform for IPPB to build convergent financial solutions with participating start-ups.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone and inaugurated various projects worth Rs 22,000 crore at a function held in Dahod, Gujarat. Regional Water Supply Scheme in Dahod District Southern Region which is constructed on Narmada River Basin at a cost of about Rs.840 crore and Dahod Smart City, which has been constructed at a cost of about Rs.335 crore. These projects include integrated command and control center building, stormwater drainage system, sewerage works, solid waste management system and rainwater harvesting system.
- ♦ New research traces pre-eruption warning signs at New Zealand's Whakari White Island volcano and other active volcanoes. The nature of each volcano is different. Some have crater lakes and some have dry craters.


