- ◆ 1933: The plane took off for the first time over Mount Everest, the world's highest peak.
- ♦ 1999 : India launched the first global telecommunication satellite INSAT 1E.
- ♦ 2007: The 14th SAARC Summit began in New Delhi.
- ◆ 1942 : Japan launched the last round of military action against America in World War II.
- ♦ 1903 : India's famous actress Jaya Prada was born.

Current Affairs Related to 3th April

- The World Health Organization and the Government of India signed a Memorandum of Understanding to create a global center for traditional medicine in Gujarat. According to a WHO statement, the inauguration of the new WHO Global Center for Traditional Medicine in Jamnagar, Gujarat, India will take place on April 21, 2022.
- India Ratings and Research has lowered India's GDP growth forecast to 7.7.2 percent in FY2023. Earlier in January, ratings agency Ind-Ra. had estimated this rate to be 7.6 percent. In Scenario I, the crude oil price is likely to be raised for three months, and in Scenario two, the estimate is for six months, both with half the cost pass-through to the domestic economy.
- ♦ The winner of the third edition of India's SAFF U18 Women's Football Championship has been announced. The 2022 edition of the international football competition for the women's under-18 national teams was held at JRD Tata Sports Complex, Jamshedpur in Jharkhand. The winner of the tournament was Highest goal scorer who scored five goals in total.
- Indian Air Force has unveiled a new initiative in association with Indian Oil Corporation Limited. Under this, the IAF convoy will be fueled at the state-run energy major's fuel stations. According to the Defense Ministry, Fleet Card-Fuel on Move has been introduced to facilitate refueling of convoys belonging to the Indian Air Force. Under the current system, the Indian Air Force procures fuel from various agencies and then distributes it within the Air Force installation.
- Dr. Renu Singh has been appointed as the next Director of Forest Research Institute in Dehradun by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. She will be the second woman director of the institute. AS Rawat, Director General, ICFRE, has handed over the additional charge of Director of FRI to Singh.

- ♦ CHANDIGARH: The Punjab Government has resolved to install three statues in the Vidhan Sabha Building of the Capitol Complex, Chandigarh. It has been opposed by the city's heritage experts.
- Rajya Sabha approved the Constitution (Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Order (Amendment) Bill, 2022. The bill was introduced in the Upper House of Parliament in February. Which was passed by voice vote. In this bill, the Bhogta caste has been removed from the list of Scheduled Castes. Significantly, this community is being included in the list of Scheduled Tribes in the state.
- Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Narendra Singh Tomar released a book titled Indian Agriculture and Ways to Increase Farmers' Income by 2030, Nutrition Security and Sustainable Food and Agriculture System at an event organized by NITI Aayog and Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations. Released. of 2030 and captures the results of the deliberative process of the National Dialogue by the Indian Agricultural Policy Commission and the Ministries of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, and facilitated by the FAO from 2019 onwards for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying.
- Sikkim's third Chief Minister Bhim Bahadur Gurung passed away at his residence in Lumsui in Gangtok, Sikkim. B Gurung worked as a teacher and a staff reporter for Amrita Bazar Patrika, a newspaper in Calcutta, and also edited Kanchenjunga, Sikkim's first news-based Nepali journal.
- The World Energy Transition Outlook 2022 was launched by the International Renewable Energy Agency at the Berlin Energy Transition Dialogue. The Berlin Energy Transition Dialogue has become an international forum for key stakeholders in the energy sector.
- The current President of Badminton Association of India, Himanta Biswa Sarma has been elected unopposed for a second four-year term from 2022 to 2026.
