History of May 6

- ♦ 1529: Babur defeated the rulers of Bengal and Bihar in the battle of Ghaghra.
- ♦ 1733: The first international boxing match was played.
- ♦ 1944 : Gandhiji was released from the Aga Khan Palace in Pune.
- ▶ 1967 : Zakir Hussain became the first Muslim President of India.
- ♦ 1946: Eminent jurist, prominent parliamentary leader and a trusted aide of Mahatma Gandhi, Bhulabhai Desai passed away.

Current Affairs Related to 6th May

- Qualcomm India Private Limited, a subsidiary of Qualcomm Inc. has proposed to launch and run the Qualcomm Semiconductor Mentorship Program 2022 for selected semiconductor startups in India. It aims to provide mentorship, technical training and industry outreach. Qualcomm India has entered into a partnership with C-DAC, an autonomous scientific society within the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India. It will act as an outreach partner for the program and help the participating entrepreneurs gain exposure.
- Ministry of Railways and Center for Development of Telematics signed an MoU to forge a strong collaborative working partnership for coordination and resource sharing. Under this, the solution of C-Telecom DoT in Railways and provision of telecommunication facilities in the delivery and implementation of services will be done.
- ♦ China has become the first country in the world to launch a global security initiative to uphold the principle of indivisible security. The principle of indivisible security means that no country can strengthen its security at the cost of the security of another country. The Global Security Initiative is launched with the aim of building an Asian security model for a shared, comprehensive, cooperative and sustainable security and mutual respect, openness and integration.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the Semicon India Conference 2022. Bengaluru hosted the three-day conference. The three-day conference was organized to further Prime Minister Narendra Modi's objective of making India a leader in electronics manufacturing, semiconductor/semiconductor design, production and innovation, according to a statement by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. The conference aims to serve as a springboard for the country's aspiration to become a worldwide semiconductor hub and develop a chip design and manufacturing ecosystem.

- Amazon Company announced in a shareholder bank Andy Jesse will officially become the CEO of Amazon on 5 July 2022. Amazon announced that Jesse, who is the current CEO of Amazon Web Services, will replace Jeff Bezos as CEO of the entire company in February.
- The Red Shield Division of the Indian Army entered into a tripartite agreement with the State Bank of India Foundation and the National Integration and Educational Development Organization for setting up the Red Shield Center for Excellence and Wellness under the aegis of Spear Corps. This agreement took place in Bishnupur district of Manipur. The Manipur Super 50 project is expected to be fully functional by the first week of July 2022 for the first batch of 50 students.
- The Director General of Military Operations of the Indian Army, Lieutenant General Baggavalli Somashekar Raju has been appointed as the new co-chief of the Army Staff. He was an alumnus of Sainik School Bijapur and National Defense Academy and was commissioned into the Jat Regiment on 15 December 1984. He commanded a battalion during Operation Parakram in the Western Theater and Jammu and Kashmir. He has been awarded the Uttam Yudh Seva Medal, Ati Vishisht Seva Medal and Yudh Seva Medal.
- ♦ The Landscape Garden Sitio Burle Marx of the country of Brazil received the status of a UNESCO World Heritage Site. There are more than 3500 plant species in this garden which are originally from Rio. It is considered a laboratory for vegetation and landscape experimentation.
- The Special Railway Establishment for Strategic Technology and Holistic Advancement was established in March 2016. It was established to undertake long-term railway research projects requiring technological advancement. The Directorate of Excellence was part of the Research Design and Standards Organisation. Indian Railways will merge the Geotech Engineering Directorate with the Directorate of Track and Bridges and Structures.


