Current Affairs Related to 7th May

- The Control for Cricket in India has announced the playoff schedule of the Indian Premier League 2022. At present, the 15th season of the Indian Premier League is going on. In this, a total of 10 teams are participating instead of 8 this time. The Board of Control for Cricket in India had earlier announced the schedule of 70 league matches. After this everyone was eagerly waiting for the schedule of playoff matches. BCCI has now made an official announcement of that too. In this, the playoff matches will be played from 24 to 29 May. In this, the first qualifier and eliminator match will be played at the historic Eden Gardens ground in Kolkata. Whereas Qualifier-2 and the title match will be held at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad.
- ♦ JioSaavn has named Sahas Malhotra, former director of Amazon Music and entertainment industry expert, as its new CEO. Prior to this, Sahas Malhotra worked for Sony Music India and Tips Industries. Sahas Malhotra was the Business Leader at Tips Music and Marketing Director of Tips Film Production at Tips Industries. From the JioSaavn company's Mumbai headquarters, Sahas Malhotra will manage the company's efforts in the rapidly changing and lucrative Indian market.
- Naresh Kumar has been appointed as the new Director of Corbett Tiger Reserve in Uttarakhand. He is a 1999 batch Indian Forest Service officer. Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests Girija Shankar Pandey has been given the additional charge of CEO Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority.
- ♦ India's second largest telecom operator Bharti Airtel announced that the Airtel Startup Accelerator Program has invested 7% in cloud-based networking solutions firm Conergy Technologies. Based in Navi Mumbai, Kanerji specializes in cloud-based comprehensive networking solutions for all types of enterprises.
- ◆ Tarun Kapoor has become the new advisor to Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

- India will be the official country of honor at the Cannes Film Market to be held from May 17 to May 25, 2022. A new restoration of Satyajit Ray's film Paragon will also be presented at a special screening at the film festival. It has been restored under the National Film Heritage Mission, a project initiated by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.
- ◆ Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the National Intelligence Grid Campus in Bengaluru. This will help security agencies access the data. The National Intelligence Grid will build a strong foundation for intelligence departments and provide them with state-of-the-art tools in the fight against terrorist organisations. The services of the National Intelligence Grid will be available to 11 central agencies and police of all states and union territories.
- ♦ Harshada Sharad Garud has become the first Indian player to win a gold medal in the history of the Junior World Weightlifting Championships. Indian weightlifting player Harshada Sharad Garud won the gold medal in the women's 45 kg weight category by lifting 153 kg.
 - Two groups of Indian students have won the NASA 2022 Human Exploration Rover Challenge. These two Indian student groups are from Punjab and Tamil Nadu, India. The challenge involved 91 teams, including 58 colleges and 33 high schools. Under this, students of Decent Children's Model Presidency School, Panjak, won the Engaging STEM Engagement Award in the High School Division. Under this challenge, this time a group of American and international students had to design, develop and test a manned rover on a solar system related track.
- ◆ Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport has become the world's second busiest airport with seat capacity, surpassing Dubai International Airport, according to a report by air consultancy firm Official Airlines Guide.
