- ♦ 1929 : Revolutionaries Bhagat Singh and Batukeshwar Dutt threw the Delhi Assembly bomb.
- ◆ 1985: The border war started between India and Pakistan, also known as the Second War of Kashmir.
- **1894 :** Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay, the author of India's national song Vande Mataram, passed away.
- ♦ 1857 : Sepoy Mangal Pandey of the First Indian Freedom Struggle was hanged.

- SEBI Chairperson Madhabi Puri Buch while launching an Ideathon to spur innovation said that India is ideally poised to harness technology in the securities market to deliver bespoke solutions at very low cost to individuals across the country. Butch said at the start of the Ideathon brainstorming that the implementation of fintech in the securities market presented tremendous potential for all parties involved.
- ♦ There are now 124 self-made female billionaires in the world, 6 fewer than the previous year, according to the Hurun Richest Self Made Woman in the World 2022. Three Indian women-Nayaka's Falguni Nair, Biocon's Kiran Mazumdar Shaw and Zoho's Radha Vembu feature in the latest Hurun list of women's self-made billionaires. Falguni Nair has overtaken long-time Bharti's number one billionaire Kiran Mazumdar Shaw to become India's richest self-made woman.
- ♦ USD 5,00,000 has been contributed by India to the United Nations Agency for UN Woman Empowerment and Gender Equality. This contribution was made by India to reaffirm the country's valuable partnership of gender equality and womenled development. India will work with New World to further boost our relations.
- Pulitzer-winning American poet Richard Howard has died at the age of 92. Richard Joseph Howard was born on 13 October 1929 in Cleveland, Ohio, United States. He was an American poet, literary critic, essayist, teacher, and translator. Howard won the Pulitzer Prize for Untitled Subjects in 1970 and was a National Book Award finalist in 2008 for Without Saying. His translation of Charles Baudelaire's Les Fleurs du Mal won the National Book Award in 1983.

- The World Health Organization has given a big decision regarding Bharat Biotech's Covaccine. The WHO has suspended the supply of the vaccine.
- HP acquired Poly for a purchase price of \$1.7 billion, with a total transaction value of \$3.3 billion, including debt. Poly is a manufacturer of office communication equipment such as headsets, AV conference room equipment such as desk phones and software.
- Award-winning children's author and historian Devika Rangachari has penned a new novel called Queen of Fire, which explores the story of Rani Laxmibai of Jhansi. The book focuses on Rani Lakshmi Bai's journey as a queen, soldier and statesman. The book provides a detailed account of how the queen took over the kingdom as a widow and joined the revolutionaries to revolt against the East India Company. Devika Rangachari is a historian who has conducted post-doctoral research on gender in early medieval Indian history.
- Google Pay in association with Pine Labs has launched a new feature Tap to Pay for UPI in India. Near field communication technology is used in this. It will allow users with NFC enabled Android smartphones and Google Pay linked NFC accounts to make transactions by tapping their phone at any Pine Labs Android point of sale terminal across the country.
- State Bank of India and Border Security Force signed MoU to extend special benefits to serving and retired BSF personnel and family pensioners. These special benefits will be given under the Central Armed Police Salary Package Scheme. State Bank of India will provide personal and air accident insurance cover, additional cover in case of on-duty death and permanent total disability/partial disability cover to BSF personnel.
