History of April 1

- ◆ 1969: India's first nuclear power station commissioned in Tarapur area of Maharashtra.
- ◆ 1936 : Odisha was carved out of Bihar as a new state.
- ◆ 1973 : Save the tiger campaign was launched to save the cheetahs in Corbett National Park, India.
- ◆ 1912 : Delhi was declared the capital of India and a province.

Current Affairs Related to 1th April

- The central government has notified the revised wage rates under the rural employment program MGNREGA. These salary revisions have been done for the financial year starting from 1st April 2022. The central government fixes the wage rate every year for unskilled manual laborers working under the Rural Employment Guarantee Program under the MGNREGA Act 2005.
- ♦ Union Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Thakur has launched a Skill India International project for the Indian tenure. The name of this international project is Training for Emirates Jobs and Skills. The project was launched at the India Pavilion at the Dubai Expo. The objective of this project is to provide skill, certification and employment abroad to Indians. This will provide avenues to prepare the Indian workforce in UAE for skilling and market needs. Tejas aims to create a 10,000-strong Indian workforce in the UAE during the initial phase.
- Togo's Gilbert Hongbo will be the next Director-General of the International Labor Organization. Hongbo was elected by the UN agency's governing body, which included representatives from governments, workers and employers, during their meeting in Geneva. Hongbo, the former prime minister of Togo, will be the 11th head of the agency and the first African to hold office. His five-year term will start from October 1, 2022.
- The Living Root Bridge of Meghalaya has been included in the potential list of UNESCO World Heritage Site. This prospective list is a list of properties that each country considers for nomination. The Living Root Bridges in Meghalaya highlight the socio-cultural, social and botanical relationship between people and nature. These living root bridges are found in more than 70 villages of Meghalaya. The In Living Root Bridge is locally called Jingjiang Jiri. It is one of the biggest attraction centers of Meghalaya.

- Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu released a book titled Poorti Pradat Shree Somaiya authored by Shyam Prasad. The book is based on the life story of Late Sri Sompally Somaiya, a social worker from Andhra Pradesh.
- Sumitra Gandhi Kulkarni, Grand Daughter of Mahatma Gandhi, inaugurated the web portal Modi Story. The Modi Story website is a volunteer-driven initiative that aims to bring together inspiring stories related to Prime Minister Narendra Modi from people who have interacted with him through his life journey over the decades. modistory in can be done in the next access of the portal.
- ♦ Timothée Chalamet and Zendaya starrer sci-fi thriller Dune won six at this year's Oscars. Dune was nominated in 10 categories and won 6 of them. The win was a proud moment for India, as Namit Malhotra, CEO and Chairman, Double Negative, the studio that did the VFX for the film, has brought home the honour. Xham won the Academy Award for Best Visual Effects, beating Free Guy, Shang-Chi, Spider-Man: No Way Home and No Time to Die.
 - Park was inaugurated in New Jaffrabad area of East Delhi. It is a project of the West to Wealth Mission of the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India in collaboration with the Municipal Corporation of East Delhi. The park will have decentralized waste management for onsite processing of solid waste in East Delhi. It is a pilot project, which provides end-to-end solutions for waste management.
- Darshan Singh of Services in Kohima and Varsha Devi of Railways eventually defended their men's and women's titles at the National Cross Country Championships to win their 10-km event on a picturesque but tough course, made more difficult by 60 per cent humidity and gusts of wind. happened.
