- ♦ 1526: After the victory in the first battle of Panipat, Babur entered the then capital of India, Akbarabad (Agra).
- ♦ 1796 : Napoleon defeated Austria at the Battle of Lodi Bridge.

- 2005 : India and Pakistan agreed to start Lahore-Amritsar bus service.

Current Affairs Related to 10th May

- Canara Bank has launched Skill Loan/Skill Loan in association with Kerala, an additional skill acquisition program under the Department of Higher Education. Under this facility, loans ranging from Rs 5000 to Rs 1.5 lakh will be provided. The loan will be provided to those students who are undergoing skill training in skill training programs, who are taking part in skill development programs offered by ie Kerala or any other agencies recognized by the Central or State Government. The loan will be provided to the students without any collateral and the repayment period will be three to seven years.
- Arvind Krishna has been elected to the Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. The bank announced that 60-year-old Krishna has been elected as a Class B director. Krishna will hold the post till December 31, 2023, the statement said. IIT Kanpur-educated Arvind Krishna will join the Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. He has been selected as Class B director by the bank. He is currently the Chairman and CEO of IBM.
- The State of the World's Forests in 2022 comes against the backdrop of the Glasgow Leaders' Declaration on Forests and Land Use and the importance of three forest pathways to achieve green recovery and address environmental crises such as climate change and biodiversity loss, is checked. Eliminate forest loss by 2030 and support restoration and sustainable production and consumption.
- A Joint Declaration of Intent was signed by the Union Minister of Energy, New and Renewable Energy, RK Singh and the German Minister of Economic and Climate Change, Dr. Robert Hebeck, on India and the German Hydrogen Task Force. India has emerged as a global leader in the energy transition with the world's highest pace of expansion in renewable energy capacity.

- The United Nations unveiled its Energy Action Plan for 2025. This action plan was initiated by about 30 major organizations including UN-Energy. It aims to accelerate action towards achieving the ambitious goal of clean, affordable energy for all and net-zero carbon emissions. An Energy Compact Action Network has also been launched.
- Union Minister of Information and Broadcasting Anurag Singh Thakur has announced that India will be the official Country of Honor in the upcoming Marche du film, which is held in conjunction with the Cannes Film Festival in France. This year the 75th edition of the Cannes Film Festival is being held in France. The Country of Honor status ensures India's presence as a focus country at the Marche du Films launch night being held at Majestic Beach and India as its cinema highlights its culture and heritage.
- A loan scheme named Jivala has been launched by the Prisons Department of Maharashtra for the prisoners serving sentences in various jails of Maharashtra. That scheme, implemented by the Prisons Department and the Maharashtra State Co-operative Bank, has been started in the Yerwada Central Jail in Pune. Banks and jail officials believe that the credit/loan scheme for prisoners still serving sentences in India could be the first of its kind. Jivala in Marathi means affection/love.
- Times Higher Education has released the 2022 edition of its Impact Ranking. 8 universities in India are among the top 300 universities in the world. The ranking is topped by Western Sydney University, followed by Arizona State University, Western University Canada. A record 1524 institutions from 110 countries participated in the rankings this year.
- ♦ ISRO has launched its Moon and Mars missions. Now ISRO is preparing a spacecraft to orbit Venus, that is, ISRO now has plans for a Venus mission.
