#### **History of April 11**

- ◆ 1930 : Lakshman Jhula made of steel wires was opened to the public in Rishikesh.
- ◆ 1827: India's great thinker, social worker and revolutionary Jyotiba Phule was born.
- **1869**: Kasturba Gandhi, wife of Mahatma Gandhi, was born.
- ◆ **2009**: Famous Hindi litterateur, playwright and story writer Vishnu Prabhakar passed away.
- ♦ 1999 : Agni 2 missile was test fired.

#### **Current Affairs Related to 11th April**

- Punjab National Bank has implemented Positive Pay System, which is mandatory for check payments of Rs.10 lakh and above. This is being done as a step to protect over 180 million customers from any security threats. The bank had last month announced making the positive pay system mandatory. Under the new system, checks of higher value of Rs 10 lakh and above will be cleared using PPS after reconfirmation with the check issuer.
- The US Senate has confirmed the name of Ketanji Brown Jackson as a Supreme Court judge. Jackson will be the first black woman judge on the US Supreme Court. To confirm his name, the Senate voted in the ratio 53:47. Justice Jackson was nominated by President Joe Biden. President Biden has described this confirmation as a historic moment for the country.
- The Government of India has introduced the Weapons of Mass Destruction and their Supply System Amendment Bill 2022 in the Lok Sabha. The Bill envisages a prohibition on the financing of any activity related to weapons of mass destruction and empowers to take action against the financiers of such activities.
- The Ministry of Rural Development has notified new wage rates under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act for the financial year 2022.23. The wage rates have been notified under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005. The MGNREGA wage rate is fixed according to changes in the Consumer Price Index—agricultural labour, which reflects an increase in inflation in rural areas.
- Veteran Bengali writer and noted litterateur Amar Mishra has won the prestigious O. Henry Award for 2022. Sahitya Akademi Award winner Amar Mishra has been given this award for The Best Short Stories 2022 for Gaoburo. Gaoburo (also known as Intva) is a short fiction story. This story written in Bengali language is based on rural background.

- Union Minister of Jal Shakti launched digital dash-board for District Ganga Committees. Representatives of more than 100 District Ganga Committees of Ganga basin also participated in the meeting. This digital dashboard will help the city in enhancing the connectivity of the people and the river. The launch of the Digital Dashboard will play an important role in the success of the Namami Gange programme. The objective of this dashboard is to ensure that cleaning of Ganga becomes a priority under the chairmanship of District Magistrates. In this dashboard, the performance of CBS will be analyzed on the basis of various parameters including monthly meetings.
- The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has started a pilot project to implement One Health Framework by One Health Support Unit in the state of Uttarakhand. The primary function of this unit is to develop One Nation, One Health roadmap based on pilot project implementation. Some of the key activities to be undertaken as part of this pilot project include institutionalizing the data collection mechanism on disease outbreak, spread, management and development of targeted surveillance plan, integrating the network of laboratories, communication strategy across sectors. develop and implement.
- The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India, has started a pilot project in Uttarakhand to implement the One Health Framework through the One Health Support Unit. The main goal of the unit is to create a National One Health Roadmap based on the lessons learned during the deployment of the pilot project. The implementation of a Health Support Unit will be led by an Inter-Ministerial One Health Committee headed by the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India.
