History of May 11

- ♦ 1857 : Sepoy Mutiny broke out in Delhi.
- ◆ 1784 : A peace treaty was signed between Mysore and the British ruler Tipu Sultan.
- ◆ 1922: The air broadcast of the radio station's GU began.
- 1857 : During the first war of independence, Indian soldiers captured Delhi from the British authorities.
- 1951: President Rajendra Prasad inaugurated the newly constructed Somnath temple.

Current Affairs Related to 11th May

- The Asian Olympic Council has announced that the Asian Games 2022, to be held in Hangzhou, China, in September has been postponed to 2023 due to the rising COVID-19 cases in the country. The Asia Olympic Council is the governing body of the Asian Games. The council said it would announce the new dates for the 19th edition of the Games. The ASEAN Games 2022 was originally scheduled from September 10 to 25. OCA also announced that the third edition of the ASEAN Youth Games to be held in Shantou in December has been cancelled. This year's World University Games 2021, to be held in Chengdu from June 26 to July 27, has also been extended to 2023.
- ♦ Sabane has broken the record at the running track meet in San Juan Capistrano, California, USA. He now holds three national records in 5000m, half-marathon and 3000m steeplechase. In the meet held in Sanu Juan, Olympic champion Jakob Ingebrigtsen took the top spot with a time of 13:02:03.
- ♦ Telangana State Government has announced the extension of insurance coverage for handloom and power loom weavers under the Nethanna Bima Yojana. The state government has issued orders to increase the insurance coverage of weavers to Rs 5 lakh under the insurance scheme. Now the insurance coverage fixed for weavers has gone at par with the insurance coverage of farmers.
- ♦ InterGlobe Aviation announced that Venkataramani Sumantran has been named as the Chairman of IndiGo Board. Sumantran has worked in America, Europe and Asia during his career spanning more than 37 years. He is a corporate leader, technocrat and educationist. Sumantran is the Managing Director and Chairman of the strategic advisory firm Celeris Technologies.
- ♦ Shooter Dhanush Srikanth won the gold and Shaurya Saini bronze medal in the men's 10m air rifle event at the 24th Blind and Deaf Olympics in

- Caxias do Sul, Brazil. Later the Indian badminton team also won the gold medal beating Japan by 3-1 in the final making it a double celebration for the country.
- The first train set of India's first Regional Rapid Transit System has been completed in Savli, Gujarat. The keys of the first RRTS train set were handed over by the Managing Director of Alstom to Manoj Joshi, Chairman, National Capital Region Transport Corporation and Vinay Kumar Singh, MD. The RRTS train sets are manufactured under the Make in India initiative and allow the train to reach a top speed of 180 kmph. The train will be taken to Duhai Depot in Uttar Pradesh, where it will be repaired and operated.
- In the board meeting of TVS Motor Company, Sudarshan Venu was appointed as the Managing Director. TVS Motor Company is a leading global manufacturer of two wheelers and three wheelers. Sudarshan has shaped the fortunes of one of India's leading two wheeler manufacturers, making it the most award winning two wheeler company. Sudarshan was instrumental in the growth of the company both within India and in overseas markets including Asia, Africa and Europe.
- RailTel Corporation of India Limited designed and installed the Health Cloud at Visakhapatnam campus of Andhra Pradesh Med Tech Zone. Andhra Pradesh Med Tech Zone is the world's first integrated medical device manufacturing centre. The Health Cloud, built on the premises of the AMTZ, was inaugurated by Louis Egersnap, Head of the WHO Innovation Hub at WHO-Geneva.
- NASA's climate research scientist Cynthia Rosenzweig has been awarded the World Food Prize 2022. He has spent much of his career explaining how global food production should adapt to a changing climate. Agronomist and climatologist Cynthia Rosenzweig has been awarded a \$2,50,000 award in recognition of her innovative model on the impact of climate change on food production.


