History of May 12

- ◆ **1666** : Under the Treaty of Purandar, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj reached Agra to meet Aurangzeb.
- ◆ **1875** : The famous philosopher, who studied Hindu philosophy, was born Krishnachandra Bhattacharya.
- ◆ **1915** : Revolutionary Rash Behari Bose left India aboard the Japanese yacht Sanuki Maru.
- ◆ **1993** : Hindi poet Shamsheer Bahadur Singh passed away.
- ◆ **1459** : Jodhpur was established.

Current Affairs Related to 12th May

- ◆ **Union Sports Minister Anurag Thakur** launched the mascot Dhakad with the official logo, 'Official Jersey' and 'Theme Song', of the 4th Khelo India Youth Games, in Panchkula. He appreciated Haryana's effort to host the Khelo India Youth Games. Haryana will set up a missile by hosting the fourth edition of the Khelo India Youth Games in Panchkula, Chandigarh, Shahabad, Ambala and Delhi from June 4 to June 13. It was scheduled to be held in the year 2021, but got delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- ◆ **The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship** has signed an MoU with the Indian Space Research Organization with the goal of augmenting the technical workforce in the Department of Space, ISRO. The MoU was signed by Mr. Rajesh Agrawal, DACMS Secretary E, and Mr. S. Somnath, Secretary, Department of Space/ ISRO Chairman. The objective of this initiative is to establish a formal framework for short-term courses to provide training for skill development and capacity building of ISRO technical professionals in the space sector in the country as per the requirements of the industry. The program will teach over 4000 ISRO technical professionals over the next five years.
- ◆ **Till 22 February 2022, about 11.78 crore farmers** have been benefited under PM Kisan Yojana. An amount of Rs 1.82 lakh crore has been disbursed to eligible beneficiaries across India at various intervals. 1.29 lakh crore has been released during the current COVID-19 pandemic period. Self-Registration Mechanism It is the process of self-registration of beneficiaries which has been made simple and easy through Mobile App, PM Kisan Portal and Walk-in through Common Service Centers to provide maximum benefits to the farmers.
- ◆ **Noted Santoor player and composer Pt. Shiv Kumar Sharma** passed away in Mumbai. He was 84 years old and died of a heart attack. Shiv Kumar Sharma was born in 1938 in Jammu. He was the first musician to play Indian classical music on the santoor.
- ◆ **Union Home Minister Amit Shah** has announced that now the next census will be e-Census and this census will shape the policies for the next 25 years. Modern techniques will be used to make the census more scientific.
- ◆ **The Uttar Pradesh government** will provide free Wi-Fi facility at more than 58 thousand places in the villages of the state. This internet facility will be available to the people within a radius of 50 meters of the Gram Sachivalaya building to be built in every Gram Panchayat of the state. High speed internet connectivity will be provided to the village secretariats to make each village a smart village and free high speed Wi-Fi internet facility will be provided to the villagers within 50 meters of the village secretariat building. The work of establishing village secretariats in 58,189 gram panchayats of the state is going on continuously.
- ◆ **The Supreme Court of India** constituted a high-level committee under the chairmanship of retired Bombay High Court judge Pradeep Nandrajog to recover money from those defaulters. This committee will take action against those who have received money decree from National Spot Exchange Limited. National Spot Exchange Limited has already secured decree and arbitration award of Rs 3,534 crore against defaulters. In addition, liabilities of Rs 760 crore have already been set aside by a committee appointed by the Bombay High Court.
- ◆ **Eun Suk-yol** has been sworn in as the President of South Korea. Amid tensions on the Korean peninsula, Eun Suk-yol began his work from an underground bunker set up in his new presidential office. He moved the presidential office and residence from the traditional Blue House as part of a plan. He has considered North Korea's nuclear weapons program and inflation as the main challenger.
- ◆ **Department of Telecommunications** for all telecom license holders Network Operation and Control Centre Fee abolished.

To enhance the economic and educational status of girls, this scheme is being implemented by the Madhya Pradesh government since the year 2007.
