History of May 13

- ♦ 1648: The construction of the Red Fort in Delhi was completed.
- ♦ 1918: India conducted two nuclear tests in Pokhran, Rajasthan.
- ♦ 1952: The session of the first Parliament of in dependent India began.
- ◆ 1962 : Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan became the second President of the country.
- ▶ 1978: The country's first flag carrier INS Delhi decommissioned.

Current Affairs Related to 13th May

- ♦ Tomato flu, a virus has been detected in many parts of Kerala. So far, more than 80 cases of tomato flu have been reported in Kollam city. It is feared that this virus disease will increase further. The state health department has taken precautionary measures in areas where cases have been reported.
- Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan launched the second phase of Ladli Laxmi Yojana (Ladli Laxmi Yojana- 2.0). This scheme is an innovative initiative to encourage girl child to pursue higher education and make them self-reliant. To enhance the economic and educational status of girls, this scheme is being implemented by the Madhya Pradesh government since the year 2007. Ladli Laxmi Yojana is a comprehensive scheme which provides financial assistance to a girl child in installments from birth till her marriage. For this the girl's family should be a permanent resident of Madhya Pradesh. The family should come below the poverty line, that is, should not be an income tax payer. A maximum of two daughters can be registered under this scheme.
- The 106th category of Pulitzer Prize winners in Journalism, Book Drama and Music were announced. The Pulitzer Prize is an award for achievements in newspaper, magazine, online journalism, literature, and musical composition within the United States. Started in 1917, the Pulitzer Prize is a major award in the United States, which is given to those who have done remarkable work in the fields of newspaper journalism, literature and music composition. It was founded by Hungarian-American publisher Joseph Pulitzer.
- ♦ Reliance Industries has become the first Indian company to register annual revenue of over \$100 billion. Reliance Industries reported a growth of up to 22.5 per cent in consolidated net profit for the fourth quarter ended March 31, 2022. Reliance has posted strong growth in retail, digital services and oil and gas business.

- Private sector lender HDFC Bank has introduced 30 Minute Express Car Loan, an end-to-end digital new car loan solution for both existing and noncustomers. The bank has integrated its loan application with automobile dealers across India.
- Senior IAS officer Alkesh Kumar Sharma has been made Secretary, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. Prior to this, he has worked as Additional Secretary and Secretary in the Cabinet Secretariat. Alkesh Kumar Sharma previously served as Kerala's Additional Chief Secretary for Industries from May 2020 to April 2021. Sharma served as the Managing Director of Kochi Metro Rail and CEO of Cochin Smart City Mission from September 2019 to April 2021.
- The Indian Coast Guard inducted its second Air Squadron, 845 Squadron, at Coast Guard Air Enclave at Nedumbassery in Kochi. Coast Guard Director General V.S. Pathania commissioned this new Air Squadron and it is equipped with Advanced Mark III helicopters which are manufactured inhouse. The specialty of these advanced Light Helicopters is that it is an indigenous Hellcutter, and it is a Tri-Engine Helicopter, manufactured by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited under the Make in India campaign.
- Abhinav Deswal has won India's second gold medal in shooting at the 24th Deaf Olympics in Caxias do Sul, Brazil. Before winning gold in the shoot-off, he was tied with silver-winning Ukrainian Oleksiy Lejebnik. India has won four medals in the shooting competition at the 24th Deflympics.
- The Indian Navy plans to procure Geo Imaging Satellite-2, a specialized earth imaging satellite, in this financial year as part of its modernization and network-centric warfare and communications programme. The satellite is expected to improve the operational capabilities of the Navy in the Indian Ocean region, which is strategically and geopolitically important given China's growing influence.
