History of April 13

- ♦ 1648: The construction of the Red Fort was completed.
- ♦ 1699: The tenth Guru of the Sikhs, Gobind Singh founded the Khalsa Panth.

Current Affairs Related to 13th April

- The Union Cabinet has approved the scheme for distribution of fortified rice in government schemes. Under this, fortified rice will be distributed in schemes like public distribution system and nutrition services for school children and Anganwadi beneficiaries. The cost of this scheme is Rs 2700 crore, which will be borne by the central government. The scheme will be implemented in a phased manner in all the states and union territories of the country by 2024.
- ♦ Charles Leclerc has won the Formula One 2022
 Australian Grand Prix held in Victoria, Melbourne.
 It was the third round of the 2022 Formula One
 World Championship. Sergio Perez finished second and George Russell third. Verstappen was
 driving second when his car broke down during
 lap 18. Red Bull's Sergio Perez finished second,
 ahead of Mercedes' George Russell and Lewis
 Hamilton.
- Rolls-Royce have opened their combined aerospace engineering and digital innovation center in Bangalore, Karnataka. The center has been established to provide high-end R&D services integrated with advanced digital capabilities for Rolls-Royce's engineering and group business services from India. As part of this collaboration, Infosys and Rolls-Royce will combine their aerospace, engineering and digital services capabilities to explore opportunities to drive digital and engineering innovation and associated cost optimization strategies.
- Thirteen-year-old Riya Jadon won the DGC Ladies Open Amateur Golf Championship, after a close fight with older sister Layanya Jadon. Riya also won the Junior Girls Trophy with scores of 78, 80 and 74. Over a hundred women golfers took part in this year's tournament, which resumed at the Delhi Golf Club after a gap of two years.

- South Central Railway has launched One Station One Product campaign at six main stations of its six divisions. SCR in-charge General Manager Arun Kumar Jain has opened stalls at Secunderabad station as a new initiative.
- The national capital Delhi is facing record heat in the month of April due to severe heatwave. With the first 15 days at 42.4 °C, the day was recorded as the hottest day of April in 5 years. According to the India Meteorological Department, this is the first time in 72 years that Delhi has recorded such a high temperature in April. In view of the heat, IMD has released Orange. Earlier, the maximum temperature in the national capital was recorded at 43.2 degree Celsius on April 21, 2017.
- The Securities and Exchange Board of India has constituted two expert groups to look into the responsibilities, qualifications and functions of sponsors and trustees in asset management firms. A sponsor, similar to a promoter, provides funds for setting up an AMC, while a trustee acts as a supervisor and is responsible for protecting the interests of investors. SEBI said in a statement that an alternative set of eligibility standards may be developed to allow new players who would otherwise be ineligible to act as sponsors to do so.
- ♦ The Airports Authority of India has launched the Opportunity Initiative to encourage and provide the right opportunities to the talents of women, artisans and craftsmen. Opportunity meant the airport as a location for the skilled craftsmen of the region.
- The United Nations General Assembly has suspended Russia from the Human Rights Council. The suspension comes as a global reaction to the alleged atrocities committed by Russia in Ukraine. With this, Russia has become the second country to be stripped of membership rights from this Council of Rights. Earlier in 2011, the North African country of Libya was suspended from membership.
