History of April 15

- ◆ 1895 : Bal Gangadhar Tilak inaugurated Shivaji Utsav at Raimgarh Fort.
- ♦ 1994: The GATT agreement was ratified by 109 countries including India.
- ♦ 1948 : The state of Himachal Pradesh was established.
- 1923: Insulin became available in the market for people suffering from diabetes.
- 1469: Guru Nanak, the founder of Sikhism, was
- ◆ 1563 : Arjun Dev, the fifth Guru of the Sikhs, was born.

Current Affairs Related to 15th April

- Rajasthan Royals all-rounder Ravichandran Ashwin became the first player in IPL history to retire during the high-octane clash against Lucknow Super Giants. Rajasthan lost four wickets for 67 runs. Ashwin then played a crucial innings of 28 runs off 23 balls and lifted Rajasthan's innings from a difficult period. During the final over, the veteran all-rounder sacrificed himself to retire in the middle to make room for Riyan Parag, who has a slightly better ability to clear the boundary in the final overs.
- National Time Release Study 2022 released. It is an initiative led by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs. The Time Release Study is an internationally recognized tool supported by the World Customs Organization. Its purpose is to measure the efficiency and effectiveness of international trade flows. Based on the results of NTRS, government agencies involved in crossborder trade are able to take remedial action to reduce the time taken for cargo release.
- The 2-2 Dialogue between India-US Defense and Foreign Ministers was held in America. In this dialogue, India's Foreign Minister M. Jaishankar and Defense Minister Rajnath Singh met their American counterparts Antony Blinken and Lloyd Austin. The dialogue was hosted by US Secretary of State Antony Blinken and Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin. This is the first 22 talks between India and the US under the Biden administration.
- Shahbaz Sharif was elected as the new Prime Minister of Pakistan through voting in the National Assembly of Pakistan. Shahbaz Sharif is the leader of the opposition party of Pakistan. The joint opposition parties had nominated 70-year-old Sharif for the post of prime minister. While former foreign minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi was nominated by Imran Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf as its candidate.

- P Gopi Krishna, Chairman, during the launch of Vikas Siri Sampat-1111 scheme in Dharwad, announced that 1111 days' deposit pays 5.70 percent interest to general public and 6.20 percent to senior citizens. The scheme allows depositing a minimum of ten thousand rupees and a maximum of two crore rupees. According to Gopi Krishna, customers should take advantage of the low interest rate, as it is available only for a limited period of time.
- The International Cricket Council announced that Pakistan captain Babar Azam and Australia's runmachine Rachel Haynes were named the Men's and Women's Players of the Month for March 2022. Under the ICC Player of the Month initiative, fans can continue to vote every month for their favorite men and women cricketers across all formats of international cricket.
- ♦ Researchers from the Indian Institute of Technology Madras have unveiled India's first polycentric prosthetic knee. who seeks to improve the condition of thousands of people with disabilities. Kadam is a polycentric knee prosthesis designed in association with Society for Biomedical Technology and Mobility India for knee prosthesis and is also a Made in India product.
- Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the Seema Darshan project at Nadabet on the Indo-Pak border in Gujarat's Banaskantha district. This project was started with the aim of providing an opportunity to the citizens to observe the life and work of BSF personnel on our border. Tourists can see missiles, tanks, planes etc which are used by Indian Army and BSF at Nadabet.
- ♦ Two Hindustan Aeronautics Limited Dhruv Advanced Light Helicopters Mark III were inducted into the Indian Coast Guard. The helicopters will be based at the Coast Guard Aviation Squadron in Kochi. These helicopters were the ninth and tenth in the series of the 16 ALH.






