History of May 16

- ♦ 2008: The Supreme Court set aside the decision of the Kolkata High Court to stay the 27% OBC quota in post-graduate courses in central educational institutions.
- ♦ 1933 : Famous litterateur Gulsher Khan Shani was born.
- **2008**: Prime Minister Manmohan Singh arrived in Thimphu on a two-day visit to Bhutan.
- ◆ 1929: The first Academy Awards were given in Hollywood.
- **2004 : Roger Federer** won the Hamburg Masters title.

Current Affairs Related to 16th May

- India successfully launched an extended range version of the Brahyos Air. This was the first launch of an extended-range version of the Brahyos missile from a Su-30MKI aircraft. This missile hit the target set in the Bay of Bengal region directly. Brahyos is the heaviest weapon to be deployed on India's Sukhoi-30 MKI fighter aircraft. With this, the IAF has acquired the capability of carrying out precision strikes against land and sea at very long ranges from the Su-30MKI aircraft.
- ♦ Tata Sons has announced the appointment of Campbell Wilson as the Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director of its airline Air India. Wilson is the CEO of Scoot, a subsidiary of Singapore Airlines. Wilson has 26 years of experience in this industry. Apart from the full service airline, he has also been in the airlines providing affordable services.
- India's national broadcaster Prasar Bharati has signed a memorandum of understanding with Madagascar's official ORTM for cooperation in broadcasting. Indian Ambassador Abhay Kumar and ORTM Director General Jean Yves signed a MoU. The objective of the MoU is to exchange programmes, examine co-creation of programs and exchange of persons. Prasar Bharati's internal programs in culture, education, science, entertainment, sports news and other areas of mutual interest will be broadcast on Madagascar National Television.
- Indian archers won a total of 14 medals, including eight gold, four silver and two bronze medals, in the Asia Cup 2022 Stage II held in Sulaimaniyah, Iraq. Young archers won four medals. On the other hand, Indian archers added 10 more medals to the medal tally on the last day of the competition. Indian team of women archers Preneet Kaur, Aditi Swamy and Sakshi Choudhary defeated Kazakhstan to win India's first gold medal in the Continental Meet.

- Apple has lost its status as the most valuable company in the world. Saudi petro company Aramco has overtaken Apple in this matter. Due to the slowdown in the technology sector, where the prices of Apple's shares have come down, the Saudi company's shares have risen due to the continuous rise in oil prices. Aramco's market registration has increased to 2.42 lakh crores, while Apple's has come down to 2.37 lakh crores.
- The Archaeological Survey of India has been doing excavation work for the last 32 years at Rakhi Garhi (Indus Valley site) in Haryana. The Archaeological Survey of India, now working in Rakhi Garhi, Haryana, has discovered a 5000-year-old jewelery factory during excavations. This is one of the biggest discoveries ever made by the Archaeological Survey of India at Rakhi Garhi, Haryana.
- Indian architect Balkrishna Vithaldas Doshi was awarded the prestigious Royal Gold Medal 2022. The Royal Gold Mendel is one of the world's highest honors for architecture by the Royal Institute of British Architects London, United Kingdom. The 2022 Honors Committee to select the Royal Gold Medalists was chaired by Simon Allford, President of The Royal Institute of British Architects, and other eminent personalities from the region.
- ♦ The Supreme Court has stayed proceedings in various high courts on petitions challenging the efficacy of the regulatory framework for social media and over-the-top platforms. These regulatory frameworks have been established by the Information Technology Rules 2021 and the Cable Television Networks Rules 2021.
- According to the Global Annual to Decadal Climate Update report released by the World Meteorological Organization, India may be among the few regions globally where temperatures are predicted to be below normal for the year 2022 and the next four years. The year 2022 will be cold in India along with Alaska and Canada.
- ♦ Ranil Wickremesinghe appointed as the new Prime Minister of Sri Lanka.




