#### **History of May 17**

- 2010 : Indian boxers won all the six gold medals of the Commonwealth Boxing Championships.
- ♦ 1769: The East India Company imposed various restrictions on the weavers to ruin the textile industry of Bengal.
- ◆ 1865 : Celebration of World Communication Day started.
- ◆ 1749 : Edward Jenner, the famous Physician and inventor of the smallpox vaccine, was born.
- ♦ 1756 : Britain declared war on France.

#### **Current Affairs Related to 17th May**

- The meeting of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization regional counter-terrorism structure will be held in Delhi from May 16 to 19. The meeting is taking place at a time when India is the current chairman of the CBC Executive Council. The meeting will be hosted by India and will be attended by a three-member Pakistani delegation. This will be Pakistan's first delegation to India after the new government takes over in Islamabad.
- Lionel Messi has topped the Forbes Highest-Paid Athlete 2022 list with a reported income of US\$130 million. It is followed by basketball player, LeBron James at the second position with USD 121.2 million, while Cristiano Ronaldo is at the third position with USD 115 million.
- ♦ Tomato flu disease has affected a large number of children. Tomato flu or tomato flu is a common virus infection that causes fever in children under the age of five. The disease usually begins with a burning sensation in the skin and loss of water in the body. A child infected with flu develops tomato-like rashes, which are usually red in color, hence it is called tomato flu or tomato fever.
- India has contributed USD 8,000 to the United Nations as part of the organization's initiative to increase public outreach in Hindi. The country's Deputy Permanent Representative to the United Nations, R. Ravindra handed over a check to a United Nations project launched by India in 2018 to disseminate information about the United Nations to the Hindi-speaking population across the world.
- ♦ According to the Global Annual to Decadal Climate Update report released by the World Meteorological Organization, India may be among the few regions globally where temperatures are predicted to be below normal for the year 2022 and the next four years.

- To increase employment opportunities, Skill India International Center will be set up in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh. A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and UAE World for the development of Skill India International Centre. Skill India International Centers aims to provide high quality training to Indian youth. These centers will host training facilities, which will skill the youth of the country as per the demand of various international employers located in countries like Canada, UAE, Gulf Cooperation Council region.
- Union Bank of India has launched an online platform Trade nxt. It enables Corporates and MSMEs to conduct all cross border export import transactions from their location. That is, now companies do not need to go to the bank branch for this. It provides seamless entry and processing of letters of credit, bank guarantees, export/import bills, disbursement of export credit, remittances and remittances, dealer financing, etc.
  - The world's leading brokerage firm Morgan Stanley has reduced India's GDP growth forecast for the financial year 2023 in view of the sharp rise in crude oil prices and the slow pace of the world economy. This rating agency has reduced the GDP estimate from 7.9 percent to 7.6 percent. US brokerage firm Morgan Stanley has also cut its growth forecast for FY2024 from 7 per cent to 6.7 per cent. However, the Indian economy will expand further above the pre-pandemic growth rate in FY2023 and 2024.
- The Supreme Court has stayed proceedings in various high courts on petitions challenging the efficacy of the regulatory framework for social media and over-the-top platforms. These regulatory frameworks have been established by the Information Technology Rules 2021 and the Cable Television Networks Rules 2021.
