- ♦ 1984 : Astronaut Rakesh Sharma became the first Indian astronaut to go into space under the mission Soyuz T-11.

Current Affairs Related to 2th April

- A museum of all former Prime Ministers, the Pradhan Mantri Sangrahalaya (Prime Ministers' Museum) has been built at Teen Murti Estate in Delhi. The Rs 270 crore project will be inaugurated on April 14, 2022 at Teen Murti Bhawan complex, which was the residence of former PM Jawaharlal Nehru. The museum will showcase the lives, times and contributions of all the 14 Prime Ministers of India, except for the collections and works on Jawaharlal Nehru, who has a separate Nehru Memorial Museum, which was also his residence
- ◆ Max Life Insurance Company Limited has announced the launch of Max Life Smart Secure Plus plan through PhonePe App, a non-linked non-participating individual pure risk premium life insurance plan aimed at digitally savvy customers. Is. Customers can choose the sum insured up to Rs 10 crore and get their policies renewed through the PhonePe app.
- The National Commission for Women has started a legal aid clinic. It is being started in collaboration with Delhi State Legal Services Authority. This clinic will work to resolve the grievances of women by giving them free legal aid. It will act as a single window for redressal of grievances of women. The objective of this initiative is to provide free consultation and legal services to women.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the continuation of the Polar Science and Cryosphere Research Scheme from 2021 to 2026. The plan is implemented through the National Center for Polar and Ocean Research.
- The role of NATO is foremost, as the Russo-Ukraine War continues. Putin says he considers Ukraine a part of Russia. Ukraine has not joined NATO, mainly because of Russia's opposition and the potential for conflict. Russian President Vladimir Putin is also concerned that if Ukraine joins NATO, the coalition will arm Ukraine and keep it far away from masks.

- The world's largest express transport company FedExg has announced that its new Chief Executive Officer will be Indian American Raj Subramaniam. He has over 30 years of global experience in strategy and operations and has led the company through a period of tremendous growth.
- Multiplex companies INOX Leisure Limited and PVR Limited have announced the merger of their two companies. Inox will hold 16.66 per cent in the new firm and PVR will hold 10.62 per cent. The company will be known as PVR Inox Limited after the merger formalities. Ajay Bijli will be the Managing Director of PVR Inox Limited, Sanjeev Kumar will be the Executive Director and Pawan Kumar Jain will be the Non-Executive Chairman of the Consolidated Board.
- The Hurun Research Institute has released the Hurun Global Forty and Under Self-Made Billionaires 2022, which ranks self-made billionaires in the world aged forty years and younger. The Hurun report lists 87 self-made billionaires aged 40 and under in the world in 2022, an increase of 8 from the previous year.
- ◆ Canada qualified for the Qatar 2022 Football World Cup for the first time in 36 years after beating Jamaica by 4-0 in Toronto. The North American nation made it to the final for the first time since Mexico in 1986. Canada topped the CONCACAF qualifying group and now secured their place in the World Cup final tournament for the first time since 1986.
- Yamunotsav 2022 was organized by National Mission for Clean Ganga as part of Amrit Mahotsav celebrations of Azadi. The event was organized in collaboration with a group of NGOs. The event was organized to announce the glory of Yamuna River and pledge to keep it clean. Apart from governments, NGOs and students also participated in this grand celebration.






