## History of April 22

- ◆ 1915 : The German military used poisonous gas for the first time during World War I.
- ◆ 1921 : Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose resigned from the Indian Civil Service.
- ◆ 1970 : Earth Day was celebrated for the first time in the world.
- ◆ 1977 : Optical fiber was first used in telephone traffic.
- ◆ 1760 : Akbar II, the last Mughal emperor of India, was born

## Current Affairs Related to 22th April

- ◆ According to the Ministry of Electronics and IT (MeitY), Prime Minister Modi will inaugurate the first Semicon India 2022 conference in Bengaluru on April 29. Semicon India 2022 will be organized by Dumpjal from April 29 to May 1, 2022. This would include experts, entrepreneurs and academicians involved in semiconductor design. The conference aims to further the vision of making India a leader in electronics manufacturing, semiconductor design, manufacturing and innovation.
- ◆ Haryana emerged as the champions of the 12th Senior Men's National Hockey Championship after beating Tamil Nadu by 3.1 in a shootout after finishing 1.1 on regulation time in the final. Haryana has won the trophy for the first time since 2011. Karnataka defeated Maharashtra by 4.3 in the 3rd/4th place classification match.
- ◆ The India Pulses and Grains Association, the apex body for India's pulses trade and industry, has appointed Bimal Kothari as the new President with immediate effect. Kothari replaces Jitu Bheda who was the president of IPGA since 2018. Kothari, one of the key founding members of the association, has been the Vice President of IPGA since 2011, when it was formed. Bimal Kothari took over as the third president of the association after Pravin Dongre and Jitu Bheda.
- ◆ Exercise Kirpan Shakti, an integrated Agni Shakti exercise, was conducted by the Trishakti Corps of the Indian Army at the Teesta Field Firing Range near Siliguri, West Bengal. The exercise was led by Lieutenant General Tarun and General Officer Commanding Trishakti Corps. The aim of the exercise is to showcase the combined skill and synchronization capabilities of the Indian Army and the Central Armed Police Forces to fight in an integrated battle.
- ◆ Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari in Delhi 2021 AIMA in several categories. Pd. Presented Managing India Awards.
- ◆ According to the World Bank Policy Research Working Paper, the extreme poverty rate in India has fallen from 22.5 percent in 2011 to 10.2 percent in 2019.
- ◆ The Karnataka State Government, in association with NIMHANS and NITI Aayog, launched the Karnataka Brain Health Initiative in January. Indian cricketer Robin Uthappa has been appointed as the brand ambassador of Karnataka-Brain Health. Training of doctors in three pilot hospitals and preparations for starting brain health clinics have also started.
- ◆ The Army Commanders' Conference, an apex level biennial event, has begun in New Delhi. The conference serves as an institutional forum for high-level discussions that take major policy decisions for the Indian Army.
- ◆ Inflation based on WPI in India has risen to 14.55% for the month of March due to increase in electricity prices and rising edible oil prices. Higher rates of inflation were recorded in March 2022 due to rise in prices of mineral oil, crude petroleum and natural gas, and basic metals as there was disruption in the global supply chain due to Russia-Ukraine conflict. The inflation based inflation WPI rate in March 2021 was 7.89 percent.
- ◆ Ladakh's Additional Director General of Police SS Khandare opened Ethosh Digital's first IT Training and Services Center in Leh, marking the first step in building the IT sector. Ethosh Digital is a California-based multinational company specializing in digital communications and AR-VR products.
- ◆ With new COVID-19 variants likely cases, the Center has asked states to send sewage samples to all sentinel sites that are currently monitoring poliovirus. Sentinel surveillance is the monitoring of the rate of occurrence of specific diseases/conditions through a voluntary network of doctors, laboratories and public health departments to assess stability or change in the health status of a population.

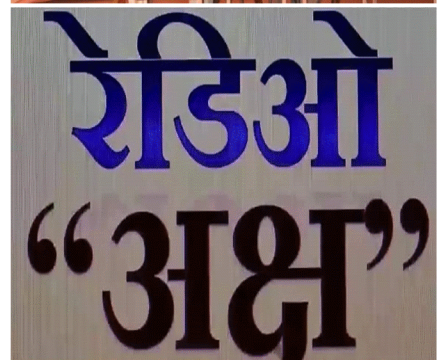

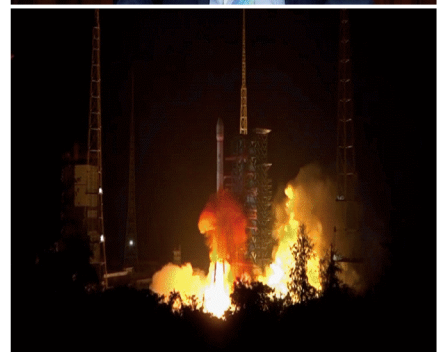
