History of May 22

- ♦ 1984: Bachendri Pal became the first Indian woman to scale the world's highest peak Everest.
- ◆ 1915 : During World War I Italy declared war on Austria, Hungary and Germany.
- 1774: Raja Rammohun Roy, the foremost in the field of religious and social development, was born.
- ♦ 1545: Sher Shah Suri, the founder and great warrior of the Sur Empire in India, passed away.

Current Affairs Related to 22th May

- The Prime Minister's Economic Advisory Council has recommended that the government implement a guaranteed employment program for the unemployed in cities and a universal basic income scheme to bridge the income gap. Given the disparity in labor force participation rates between rural and urban areas, the urban equivalent of demand-based and guaranteed employment programs like MGNREGA should be implemented so that surplus labor can be rehabilitated, according to the report titled Status of Inequality in India.
- ♦ West Central Railway has developed a battery operated dual-mode locomotive named Navdoot. This engine runs on both modes i.e. battery and electricity. Presently it is being used on trial basis during shunting of trains at Jabalpur, Mudwara and other stations. This dual mode locomotive has also received the Best Innovation Award from Railway Board. With this new locomotive, Railways will save 1000 liters of diesel per day. It will be used more after clearing all the trials.
- Union Minister Anurag Thakur inaugurated the Indian Pavilion at the Cannes Film Festival. And also released the poster of 53rd International Film Festival of India. He announced an incentive scheme for video visual co-production and shooting of foreign films in India. Under this scheme, international film production companies can claim reimbursement of up to 30 per cent on qualifying expenses in India subject to a maximum of Rs 2 crore.
- Bangladesh Prime Minister offered India access to Chittagong port in Bangladesh. Access to Chittagong port will benefit the northeastern states of India such as Assam, Tripura, Meghalaya and Mizoram. Before independence, the northeastern part of India had access to the port of Chittagong through the Brahmaputra and Barak river systems. After the Partition in 1947, India's Northeast lost its access to the sea.

- Edible oil company Ruchi Soya has announced that it will acquire the food division of Patanjali Ayurved for Rs 690 crore. As a result, Ruchi Soya is expected to gain momentum in the fast-moving consumer goods segment. Ruchi Soya Industries Limited will be renamed as Patanjali Foods Limited after regulatory approval. The 21 products of the food industry acquired include ghee, honey, spices, juices and wheat. According to company sources, Ruchi Soya will pay an annual royalty of 1% of the gross turnover of the goods to Patanjali Ayurved under the transfer agreement.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has launched two Made-in-India warships INS Surat and Udayagiri at Mazagon Docks in Mumbai. This is the first time that two indigenously built warships were simultaneously launched by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited. Both the warships have been designed in-house by the Directorate of Naval Design and built at MDL, Mumbai.
- Union Minister Bharti Pawar launched the National Emergency Life Support Course for Doctors, Nurses and Paramedics. The course will help build a cadre of trainers to train doctors, nurses and paramedics working in emergency departments of hospitals and ambulance services. Currently the health care professional is dependent on overseas modules and paid courses. The National Emergency Life Support curriculum deals with the management of medical emergencies, surgical emergencies, cardiac emergencies and respiratory emergencies.
- Delhi Lieutenant Governor Anil Baijal has resigned from his post. Delhi Lieutenant Governor Anil Baijal has submitted his resignation to President Ram Nath Kovind. He has given personal reasons behind the resignation. Anil Baijal took over as the Lieutenant Governor of Delhi in December 2016 following the resignation of Najeeb Jung.
- SAARC members Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Nepal are facing economic stalemate and Afghanistan is under the control of Islamic Taliban, due to which the future of SAARC is bleak.
