#### **History of May 27**

- ♦ 2010: India successfully test-fired nuclearequipped Dhanush and Prithvi 2 missiles in Balsora district of Chandipur, Orissa.
- ♦ 1928 : Famous historian Bipin Chandra was born.
- ♦ 1957: Nitin Gadkari, an Indian industrialist and se-
- nior politician of the Bharatiya Janata Party, was born.
- ◆ 1964: Jawaharlal Nehru, the great fighter of the Indian freedom struggle and the first Prime Minister of independent India, passed away.

#### **Current Affairs Related to 27th May**

- DGCA (Directorate General of Civil Aviation) has given Air Operator's Permit to Jet Airways. This will allow the airline to resume commercial flight operations after being shut down for more than three years. The airline aims to start operations in the second quarter i.e. between July and September. It will be a full-service carrier with business and economy class.
- State-owned Oil and Natural Gas Corporation has become the first gas producer to sell domestic gas on the Indian Gas Exchange, exchanging undisclosed quantities from the KG-DWN-98?2 block off India's coast. ONGC said in a statement that it will gradually increase production. ONGC has created history by becoming the first exploration and production company in India to trade domestic gas on the Indian Gas Exchange. Anurag Sharma, Director & In-Charge Marketing, ONGC conducted the first online trading on IGX, India's first automated national level gas exchange.
- The central government has constituted a committee to investigate the Ramban tunnel accident. This 3-member panel of independent experts will look into the reasons behind the collapse of a portion of an under-construction tunnel near Khooni Nallah between Ramban and Banihal on NH-44 in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. Along with finding out the reasons, this committee will also suggest remedial measures. Professor J.T.Sahu of HT Delhi will chair the committee. The committee will submit its report to the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways within ten days.
- ♠ Anjali Pandey, Engines and Components Business Unit Leader at Cummins India, has been honored with the Committed Leader Award at CII EXCON 2022 in Bengaluru for her efforts to create a more diverse, equitable and inclusive workplace. Cummins sees diversity, equity and inclusion as a competitive advantage and therefore a business imperative.

- Haryana hockey team defeated Jharkhand hockey team by 2-0 in the final and secured third position in Hockey India Sub-Junior Women's National Championship 2022 in Imphal by defeating Madhya Pradesh hockey team by 3-0.
- The Union Minister for Education and Skill Development Shri Dharmendra Pradhan launched the North East Research Conclave 2022 at IIT Guwahati. In his remarks, Shri Pradhan said that the conference will enhance linkages between industry, academia and policy makers, as well as revitalize the research, start-up and entrepreneurship ecosystem in the resource-rich North Eastern Region States and the country.
- ◆ Dr. Bibek Debroy, Chairman of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister, launched the Status of Inequality Report in India. The Institute for Competitiveness wrote research, which comprehensively examines the level and type of equality in India. The study combines data on inequality in health, education, household characteristics and labor market sectors. Inequality in these areas, according to research, makes the population more vulnerable and leads to multidimensional poverty.
- Manchester City have won their fourth title success 2021/22 Premier League champions.
- ◆ Formula One racing driver Max Verstappen has won the Spanish Grand Prix title.
- ◆ India has launched the fourth edition of the Coordinated Patrol with the Navy of Bangladesh in the northern episode.
- The Supreme Court has allowed mining companies to mine and export iron ore extracted from mines in the state of Karnataka.
- French Open Tennis Tournament is being organized at Roland Garros, Paris.
- ♦ The 11th edition of the Asia Cup Hockey Championship has started in Indonesia.


