History of May 29

- ♦ 2010: The President of India, Pratibha Patil, inaugurated a Buddhist temple built in the Indian style at the ancient first-century Shvetashwa White Horse temple complex in Luoyang, Henan province.
- ◆ 1865 : Freedom fighter, journalist Ramanand Chatterjee was born.
- ◆ 1727: Peter-II became the Tsar of Russia at the age of 11.
- ♦ 1953 : Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay became the first people to reach Mount Everest.

Current Affairs Related to 29th May

- Captain Abhilasha Barak of Haryana has become the first woman officer to join the Army Aviation Corps as a fighter aircraft carrier after successfully completing her training. He was awarded the prestigious wing along with 36 other Army pilots by the DG and Colonel Commandant of Army Aviation at Nashik. He is assigned to the second flight of 2072 Army Aviation Squadron. He was inducted into the Indian Army in 2018 from Officers Training Academy, Chennai.
- ♦ NASA is constantly pushing its search boundaries. In this episode, NASA's new solar sail concept, the Diffractive Solar Sailing Project, can take science to new heights. This diffractive solar sailing project was selected as part of the NASA Innovative Advanced Concepts Program for Phase III studies.
- ♦ French oil and gas major, Total Energy is expected to acquire a minority stake of 10% or more in the hydrogen business of the Adani Group, under newly formed Adani New Industries Ltd. The agreement is nearing completion, and an announcement is expected in the coming months.
- The Reserve Bank of India set up a six-member committee to assess and review customer services in regulated firms with the goal of protecting the interests of customers. The committee will provide recommendations for improving customer service, according to a statement from the banking regulator. The six-member committee will also assess the effectiveness of the customer service rules and make recommendations for improvement. Former RBI deputy governor BP Kanungo will head the committee, which will submit its report three months after its first meeting.
- ♦ Kishor Jayaraman, President of India and South Asia for Rolls-Royce has received the Honorary Officer of the Order of the British Empire by the Queen of the British Deputy High Commission.

- Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission The National Health Authority has introduced a modified Ayushman Bharat Health Account, Abha mobile application to manage health records. According to the Union Health Ministry, the Aura app, which was earlier known as the Chhakbhad Health Records App. It is available for download from Google Play Store and has already received over four lakh downloads.
- HDFC Bank, India's largest private sector bank, announced the launch of a new range of cobranded credit cards in association with Retailio. Which is aimed at chemists and pharmacies in the mass merchant market. Retailio is the largest B2B pharma marketplace in the country. It is a useful app that is making a significant digital impact on Pharma Supply Chain Management in India. Chemists, Retailers, Distributors, Pharmacists and Hospitals can use the Retailio mobile application and web interface to place orders with their respective distributors.
- JSW Group has appointed Gaurav Sachdeva as CEO of JSW One Platforms, an e-commerce venture of the group. He made the transition from his role at JSW Ventures, where he led venture capital investments for the fund. In his role as CEO of JSW One Platform, Sachdeva will aim to build an agile organization backed by the credibility and scale of the JSW Group, which will facilitate the purchase and sale of steel and other products for manufacturing and manufacturing of MSMEs in the country.
- Minister of State for Culture and External Affairs, Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi, through video conference, participated in the 7th BRICS Culture Ministers' Meeting, which was organized by the People's Republic of China and was attended by all BRICS member states. The Ministers approved the BRICS Action Plan 2022.2026, which aims to expand cultural cooperation and execute the 2015 BRICS Cultural Cooperation Agreement.




