History of May 3

- ◆ **1830** : The first regular passenger train powered by steam locomotive in the world started running.
- ◆ **1939** : Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose founded the All India Forward Bloc.
- ◆ **1947** : A new constitution came into force in Japan after World War I.
- ◆ **1961** : Commander Alan Shepard became the first American astronaut to go into space.
- ◆ **1969** : The third President of India, Zakir Hussain, passed away.

Current Affairs Related to 3th May

- ◆ The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister, approved the merger of CBC with BPT. Its purpose is to streamline the functioning of the department as well as to realize the mantra of Minimum Government Act Governance. After this merger all the movable assets and liabilities of the Consultancy Development Center will be transferred to CSIR. Apart from this, the existing 13 employees of CDC will be accommodated in CSIR by creating thirteen additional posts.
- ◆ Suryaday Small Finance Bank has partnered with IT infrastructure services provider Kindrill for a period of 5 years. It is a US based company. The bank will partner with Kindrill to drive its technology transformation programme, improve operational efficiency and increase digital banking adoption among its customers as part of the five-year transformation deal. Kindrill will drive the Bank's information technology digital transformation program, improve operational efficiency, and drive digital banking adoption among the Bank's customers.
- ◆ IndiGo has become the first airline in Asia to land its aircraft using the indigenous navigation system Gagan. This is a big leap for Indian civil aviation and a strong step towards self-reliant India as India has become the third country in the world to have its own SBAS system after USA and Japan.
- ◆ BJP leader and former union minister Vijay Sampla has been appointed as the chairman of the National Commission for Scheduled Castes for the second time. Sampla had resigned from the post of NCSC president before the Punjab elections and contested the elections. The official order for his appointment was issued by President Ram Nath Kovind.
- ◆ The Digital India RISC-V program was launched by the Government of India. The aim of which is to obtain industry grade commercial silicon and designs for the future generation of microprocessors for the country and the world and for the next generation of microprocessors by December 2023.
- ◆ Maharashtra has become the first state in India to develop a website-based migration tracking system application to track the movement of migrant workers through the Personal Unique Identification Number. The Migration Tracking System project aims to ensure continuity of Integrated Child Development Services for migrant beneficiaries, such as children below 18 years of age, lactating mothers and pregnant women registered in Anganwadi centres.
- ◆ The Union Minister for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Shri Narayan Rane has launched the Dadam Sustainable Certification Scheme. The objective of the scheme would be to encourage dadme in India to adopt zero defect zero impact practices. Banks will also be eligible for concession in processing fee and interest rate of banks along with preference in availing certified daddy loans. Additional relaxation of 10% will be given to dams run by women/ women and dams run in Himalayan region, island areas or aspirational districts.
- ◆ Atal Tunnel has been awarded the Indian Building Congress Best Infrastructure Project. The tunnel received this award during the 25th Annual Convention of the IBC. It was selected as the Best Projects for Excellence in the Built Environment in 2021. This is a 902 km long tunnel, which is built in Rohtang, Himachal Pradesh.
- ◆ Tata Consultancy Services has expanded its strategic partnership with SBI Cards & Payments Services Limited to power the digital transformation of SBI Cards. TCS helped SBI Cards transform its core card sourcing platform and digitize a significant part of the process. TCS has been providing services to SBI Cards for over a decade since 2008, and the new deal represents an extension of that relationship.

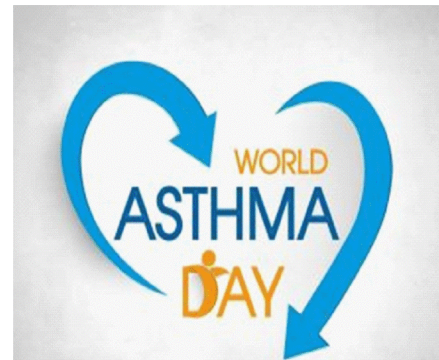

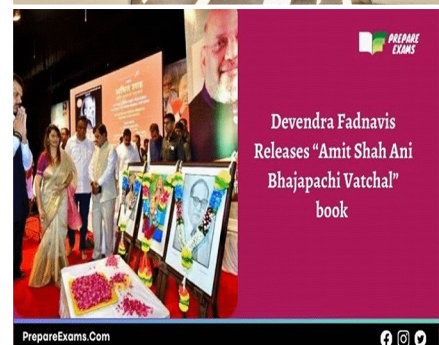
