History of May 30

- 1919: Rabindranath Tagore returned the title of Sir in protest against the Jallianwala Bagh massacre.
- ◆ 1987 : Goa became the 25th full-fledged state of the country.
- ♦ 1867 : Dar-ul-Uloom was established in Deoband

of Uttar Pradesh.

- ◆ 1826: Udant Martand the first Hindi newspaper was started, hence Hindi Journalism Day is also celebrated on 30th May.
- ▶ 1606 : Guru Arjan Dev, the fifth Guru of Sikhism, passed away.

Current Affairs Related to 30th May

- The directorship of the Indian Navy was launched at Kattupalli, Chennai. It has been built for the Indian Navy by GRSE in association with L&T Shipbuilding. The director's delivery is likely by April 2023. The survey vessel (Vraha) (SBL) by the director GRSE is the second of the four ships under construction under the project.
- The World Health Organization has reappointed Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus as the Director-General of WHO for a second term with effect from 16 August 2022. His re-election was confirmed during the 75th World Health Assembly in Geneva. He was the only candidate. Dr Tedros was first elected in 2017.
- National Achievement Survey 2021 report released. It is issued by the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education. This report assesses the health of the school education system in the country. It also reflects the overall assessment of the school education system. The objective of NAS 2021 is to evaluate children's progress and learning ability as an indicator of the efficiency of the education system.
- In one of its important orders, the Supreme Court recognized sex work i.e. prostitution as a profession. The Supreme Court issued this direction in exercise of the powers under Article 142 of the Indian Constitution. Under this, the police should neither interfere nor take criminal action against adult and consenting sex workers.
- ♦ Cases of buffalopox virus have been seen in western India. The disease has been linked to severe disease outbreaks among buffaloes, cattle and humans. This adversely affects the productivity and work efficiency of the animals.
- ♦ Reserve Bank of India has eased norms for nonbank entities to set up Bharat Bill Payment Operating Units, thereby reducing the net worth requirement to Rs.25 crore with a view to encourage more players in this segment Is.

- Writer Geetanjali Shree was awarded the International Booker Prize 2022. He has been given this honor for his translated Hindi novel Reet Ka Maqbara. With this it has become the first book in an Indian language to win the International Booker Prize. This book, originally in Hindi as Reet Samadhi, has been translated into English by Daisy Rockwell.
- Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik launched the International Olympic Committee's Olympic Value Education Program in collaboration with Abhinav Bindra Foundation Trust. It will be a value based curriculum, which will be initially implemented in 90 schools in Rourkela and Bhubaneswar, covering around 32,000 children.
- Shri Rajiv Chandrashekhar, Minister of State for Electronics & Information Technology, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, was present during a brainstorming session organized by MeitY on Mission Digital India Bhashini National Language Translation Mission. According to him startups are an essential component of our digital ecosystem and Mission Digital India Bhashaani will support them in developing India-specific and Indian languages capable IT solutions.
- Union Health Secretary, Rajesh Bhushan has been appointed as the Chairman of Committee in the 75th World Health Assembly. Committee B mainly discusses administrative and financial matters of the World Health Organization. Each year the World Health Assembly contains a long and complex list of responses to health challenges and reviews, and the Assembly functions through two committees A and B.
- Markets regulator SEBI announced that it has derecognised the Indian Commodity Exchange Limited. The recognition of the exchange was derecognised after SEBI issued an order declaring it non-compliance on several grounds including net worth and infrastructure norms.
