- ◆ **2008** : Haryana Government announced to give the benefit of family pension to girls below the age of 25 years also.

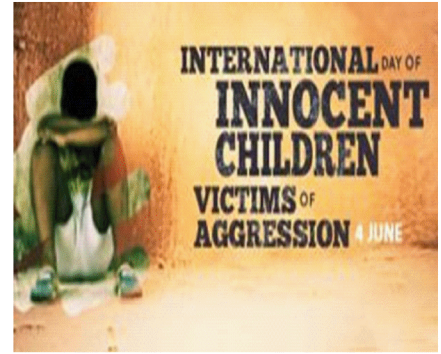
- ◆ **National Council for Teacher Education** has launched an online portal to simplify the process of recognition of teacher education programs in higher education institutions. The portal launched to streamline the process seeks to help from the time of inviting applications for courses till the issuance of accreditation orders including inspection of institutions. The applications for the recently launched four-year Integrated Teacher Education Program will be processed on this portal.
- ◆ **Gujarat hosted a two-day National Education Ministers' Conference.** The meeting was attended by Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, as well as other Union Ministers and Education Ministers of State and Union Territories. Discussions are likely to take place during this conference on how the education ecosystem of the country was promoted. The National Education Policy 2020 will focus on the implementation of school skills, and digital projects such as the National Digital Education Architecture and the National Educational Technology Platform.
- ◆ **The Permanent Indus Commission Conference, which is held annually under the Indus Waters Treaty 1960,** began with India and Pakistan. Sindhu's uncle has survived the tie-freeze as both the countries consider it as a requirement of the IWT. According to the Ministry of External Affairs, under the terms of the treaty, the two sides are expected to meet alternately in India and Pakistan at least once a year.
- ◆ **Defense Ministry signed a contract with Bharat Dynamics Limited.** This agreement has been signed for the supply of indigenously developed Astra MK-1 Beyond Visual Range missiles and related equipment. The cost of this deal is 2971 crores. These have been made for the Indian Air Force and Navy. This project will act as a catalyst for the development of infrastructure and testing facilities at BDL.
- ◆ **Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has unveiled new legislation that would implement some of the harshest gun control measures in decades,** including a freeze on the country's handgun buying and selling. Trudeau cited widespread rain-related shootings in Canada as well as recent attacks in the United States as part of his government's motivation to propose Bill C-21 during a press conference in Ottawa.
- ◆ **Dedicated to the nation under Param Anant National Supercomputing Mission, IIT Gandhinagar** has state-of-the-art supercomputers. It is a joint initiative of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology and the Department of Science and Technology, which was commissioned. This indigenous software stack is developed by C-DAC and is a Make in India first.
- ◆ **Prime Minister Narendra Modi has released the benefits of PM Cares for Children** scheme for the children who have lost their parents due to the COVID-19 pandemic. PM Modi has promised financial assistance for school education of Rs 4,000 per month for basic needs, scholarship for higher education and free treatment up to Rs 5 lakh.
- ◆ **Public sector banks have more than quadrupled their net profit in FY 2021-22.** During the financial year 2021-22, the total profit of 12 state-owned banks stood at Rs.66,539 crore. Which was 110 percent more than last year's Rs 31,816 crore. For the first time in years, all 12 public sector banks made profits. This was also a significant improvement in FY18, when out of 21 public sector banks, just two declared profits.
- ◆ **South Kashmir's radio jockey Umar Nisar has been awarded** the 01 Best Content Award and Immunization Champion Award by the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund at the annual Radio 4 Child 2022 Awards in Mumbai, Maharashtra.

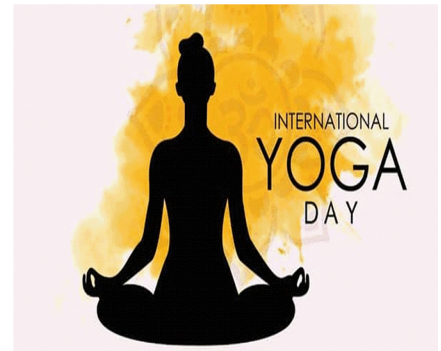

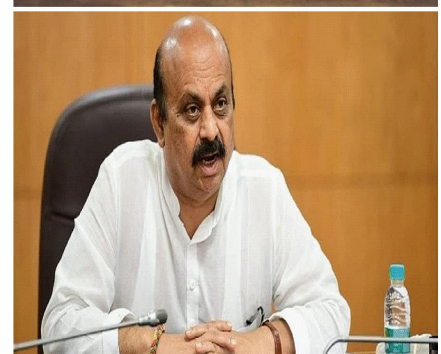
