History of April 5

- ◆ **1930** : Mahatma Gandhi along with his followers reached Dandi to break the salt law.
- ◆ **1949** : Bharat Scouts and Guides was established.
- ◆ **1979** : Country's first Naval Museum opens in Mumbai.
- ◆ **1964** : Navy celebrated National Maritime Day for the first time.
- ◆ **1961** : The first Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Limited Company sponsored by the Government of India was established.
- ◆ **1479** : Amardas, the third Guru of the Sikhs, was born.

Current Affairs Related to 5th April

- ◆ **HDFC VAULT General Insurance Company** has launched its TNS program. It is India's first industry-led digital customer engagement and rewards programme. The program is an experiment to test a new idea under IRDAI regulatory sandbox. The trial period will be till 14th May 2022 and continuation of the product beyond the trial period will be subject to IRDAI approval.
- ◆ **The National Medical Commission** has announced that medical students will now take the Maharishi Oath instead of the Hippocratic Oath. It will start with the existing batch of students standing in the country. The Hippocratic Oath is a code of ethics for fresh medical graduates, which is believed to have been written by the ancient Greek physician Hippocrates. During the convocation the oath is taken as a guide for the conduct of the medical practice.
- ◆ **Maharashtra government** has launched a scheme that allows prisoners to get personal loans up to Rs 50,000 from banks to help their families improve their living conditions and meet expenses related to their legal matters. This will be a first of its kind initiative in our country. Maharashtra State Co-operative Bank will provide loan up to Rs.50,000 under this scheme at 7% interest rate. The scheme will be implemented on a pilot basis at Yerwada Central Jail in Pune, Maharashtra.
- ◆ **The official match ball for the Al Rihla FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022** has been unveiled by Adidas. It is the 14th World Cup ball from Adidas and has been designed to accommodate the fastest playing speeds, as it flies faster through the air than any other World Cup ball.
- ◆ **Dr. S. Raju** has assumed charge as the Director General of the Geological Survey of India. He replaced RS Garkhal. Prior to this, Dr. Raju was in the post of Additional Director General and National Head of Mission III and IV at GSI Headquarters.
- ◆ **Citigroup** has announced that Axis Bank will acquire Citibank's Indian consumer business for an amount of USD 1.6 billion in a full cash deal. The transaction will take place across Citibank India's consumer banking businesses, including retail banking, credit cards, consumer credit and wealth management. The transaction will also include the sale of consumer business, Citicorp Finance Ltd., a non-banking financial company of Citibank.
- ◆ **Vishwas Patel** has been re-elected as the Chairman of the Payments Council of India for the second time in 2022, before he was elected as the President of the PCI in the year 2018. In 2013 he served as the co-chairman of PCI. PCI is a payments ecosystem industry body and a part of Internet and Mobile Association of India. PCI aims to promote a cashless transaction society and enhance digital payments in India.
- ◆ **The Indian Antarctic Bill 2022** was introduced in the Lok Sabha. The purpose of this bill is to take measures at the national level to protect the Antarctic environment and its associated ecosystem. It will provide a regulatory framework for India's research activities in the Antarctic.
- ◆ **Indraprastha University Vice-Chancellor Mahesh Verma** has been appointed as the new chairman of the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers. NABH is a constituent board of Quality Council of India. It is responsible for setting standards for quality and certified hospitals and other healthcare facilities. The National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers is also a member of the Board of the Asian Society for Quality in Healthcare. Dr. Verma is a recipient of Padma Shri as well as Dr. B. C. Roy Award. He has also received the National Science and Technology Award.

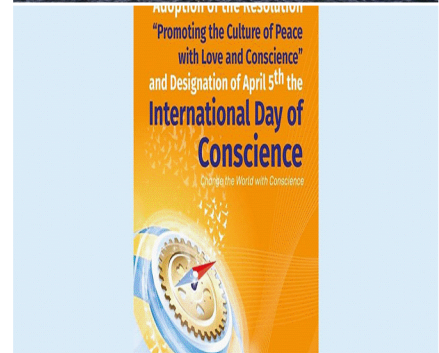

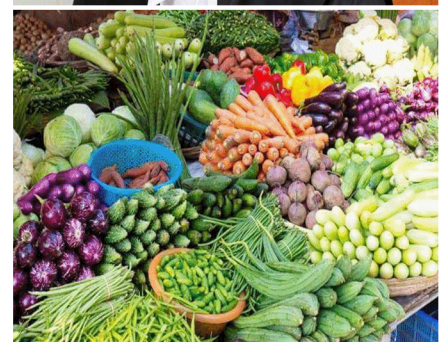

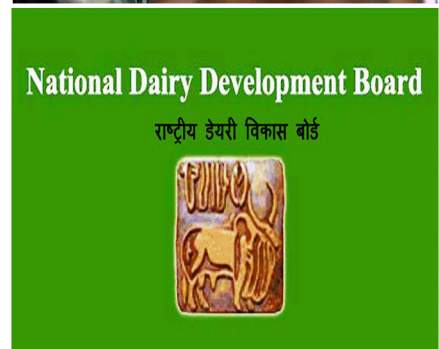
