History of May 5

- ◆ 1944 : Mahatma Gandhi was released from jail.
- ◆ 1949 : Jharkhand Party was established in India.
- ◆ 1984 : Phu Dorji became the first Indian to scale Everest without oxygen.
- ◆ 2010 : Gujjars ended the agitation after the Rajasthan government agreed to provide 1 percent reservation to Gujjars immediately and keep a backlog of 4 percent.
- ◆ 1988 : The first television broadcast was made from the summit of Everest.

Current Affairs Related to 5th May

- ◆ Health summit will be organized at national level from May 5 to 7. Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya will preside over the conference. This three-day conference will be held at the Statue of Unity in Kevadiya, Gujarat. Health ministers of all states and union territories will participate in it. The purpose of this conference is to share with others the efforts of the best performing states in controlling the cases of corona and promoting the vaccination campaign. Apart from this, the other major focus will also be to encourage the states to promote national health infrastructures.
- ◆ Maharashtra Cabinet has approved the Maharashtra Gene Bank Project. This is the first such project in India. Its purpose is to provide conservation of genetic resources within the state, including the diversity of marine fauna, seed types of local crops, and animal diversity. According to the cabinet, an amount of Rs 172.39 crore will be spent in the next five years on seven focus areas. The project will be implemented by the Maharashtra State Biodiversity Board and will be overseen by committees under the Chief Secretary and the Principal Secretary.
- ◆ The e-shram portal is being considered to be linked with the existing accident insurance scheme of the Center, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana. Its objective is to create a mechanism for settlement of accident claims of unorganized workers registered on the e-shram portal. Under this scheme, workers will be able to get direct benefit transfer through e-shram unique ID number. So far more than 26 thousand e-shram beneficiaries have registered on NCS.
- ◆ Qualcomm India Private Limited, a subsidiary of Qualcomm Inc., proposes to launch and run the Qualcomm Semiconductor Mentorship Program 2022 for selected semiconductor startups in India. It aims to provide mentorship, technical training and industry outreach. Qualcomm India has entered into a partnership with C-DAC, an autonomous scientific society within the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India. It will act as an outreach partner for the program and help the participating entrepreneurs gain exposure.
- ◆ Researchers at Massachusetts Institute of Technology have developed a portable desalination device. This device uses electrical power to remove particulates from drinking water. It is capable of delivering clean drinking water without the need for a filter. Significantly, the research related to this was published in the American Chemical Society journal Environmental and Technology.
- ◆ The Red Shield Division of the Indian Army entered into a tripartite agreement with the State Bank of India Foundation and the National Integration and Educational Development Organization for setting up the Red Shield Center for Excellence and Wellness under the aegis of Spear Corps. This agreement took place in Bishnupur district of Manipur. The Manipur Super 50 project is expected to be fully functional by the first week of July 2022 for the first batch of 50 students.
- ◆ The Sitio Burle Marques site, a landscaped garden in the Brazilian city of Rio de Janeiro, has been included in the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. There are more than 3500 plant species in the park which are native to Rio. It is considered a laboratory for vegetation and landscape experimentation. The site is named after the Brazilian landscape architect Burle Marx, whose design of parks and gardens made him world famous.
- ◆ Emmanuel Macron hopes to work on domestic and foreign policy once France takes office for the next five years, but he will soon face crucial parliamentary elections in which he struggles to retain his majority. The results will be released by the Constitutional Council and will be accompanied by a cabinet meeting by Macron.

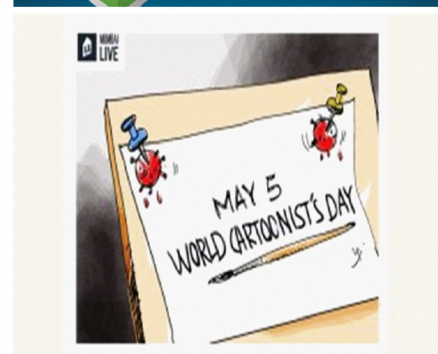
