History of June 6

- ◆ **1674** : The coronation of **Shivaji Maharaj** in the fort of Raigad as well as he assumed the title of Chhatrapati.
- ◆ **1968** : **Arvind Kejriwal**, the seventh Chief Minister of **Delhi** and **Indian social worker**, was born.
- ◆ **1997** : **India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Thailand** formed an economic cooperation group called **BISTEC** in Bangkok.
- ◆ **1999** : India's first pair of **Leander Paes** and **Mahesh Bhupathi** won the Grand Slam of Tennis.

Current Affairs Related to 6 June

- ◆ **Sachin Tendulkar** will continue to work for the welfare of underprivileged children for a record 20th year as the Goodwill Ambassador of the United Nations Children's Fund. The iconic cricketer has been associated with UNICEF for a long time for various reasons. In his nearly two decade long partnership with UNICEF, he has been instrumental in spearheading various campaigns aimed at providing a better future, especially for underprivileged children.
- ◆ The **GST revenue for May** stood at around **Rs 1.41 lakh crore**, which is **44 per cent** higher than that of the finance ministry in the same month last year. Goods and Services Tax revenue in April remained below record high collection of **Rs 1.68 lakh crore**. The GST revenue in March was **Rs 1.42 lakh crore**, while in February it was **Rs 1.33 lakh crore**.
- ◆ The **central government has handed over Rs 86,912 crore** to the state governments, **SGST** (State Goods and Services Tax), which fully compensates them for the Goods and Services Tax (GST). The Center has released the entire amount despite having only **Rs 25,000 crore** in the GST compensation pool. The balance amount was paid from the Centre's own funds while the cess was being collected.
- ◆ **Senior scientist Rajesh Gera** has been appointed as **Director General of National Informatics Centre**, in an order issued by the Personnel Ministry. He is presently Deputy Director General in NIC. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of Gera, Scientist 'G' to the post of Director General. The National Informatics Center is a Government of India organization under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, established in 1976 with the objective of providing technology-driven solutions to the Central and State Governments.
- ◆ **Senior IPS officer Zulfikar Hasan** has been appointed as the new **Director General** of the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security. The official order said that Zulfikar Hasan has been appointed for a term till his retirement on **31.10.2024**.
- ◆ **India will oppose the moratorium on customs duty on electronic transmission at the 12th WTO Ministerial Conference** beginning June 2022 as its provision favors only developed countries. At the 12th Ministerial Conference in June 2022, many OJ members may consider seeking a temporary extension of the adjournment till the 13th Ministerial Conference, but India does not want it to be continued this time around.
- ◆ **The prices of crude oil are increasing continuously and the burden on the pockets of the people is increasing.** In such a situation, the windfall tax has come into the limelight. The government is considering imposing windfall tax on oil and gas giants. This is not the first time that India is considering such an unpredictable tax. Windfall tax is a windfall tax, which is levied on a company by the government in a lump sum.
- ◆ **India's economic growth slowed to a four-quarter low of 4.1 per cent in January-March 2021-22**, reflecting the impact of the omicron wave of the COVID-19 pandemic on the manufacturing sector and contact-intensive services. The Office for National Statistics lowered its year-on-year GDP growth forecast for the full fiscal year 2021-22 to 8.7%, from 8.9 percent projected in February. The economy has declined by 6.6 percent in the year 2020.21.
- ◆ **India won the bronze medal by defeating Japan by 1.0 in the Asia Cup 2022 held in Jakarta, Indonesia.** Japan had seven penalty corners while India had just two but India led the circle in figures of 11.10. India were down 10 men in the final minute of the match but they managed to win their second bronze medal in the Asia Cup.
- ◆ **SL Thosen, a 1988 batch Indian Police Service officer, has been appointed** as the new Director General of Sashastra Seema Bal. Thosen, an IPS officer of Madhya Pradesh cadre, is serving as the Special Director General of Border Security Force.

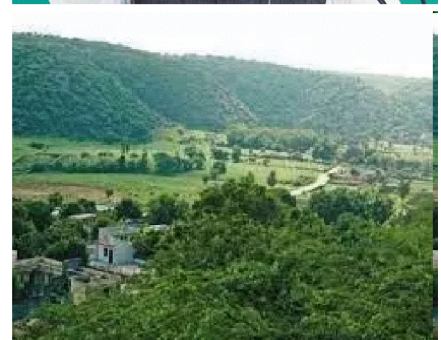

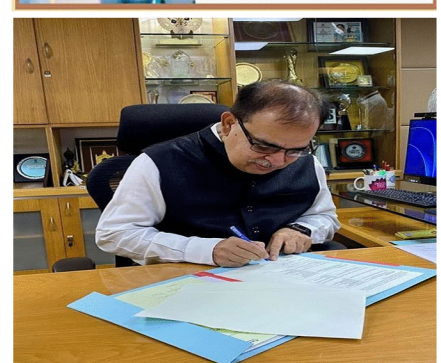
