#### **History of April 7**

- ♦ 1948: The World Health Organization, the health affairs agency of the United Nations, was established, hence it is celebrated as World Health Day.
- ♦ 1939 : Italy occupied Albania during World War II.
- ♦ 2000 : In India, Delhi Police had busted a cricket
- match-fixing and betting racket worth crores of rupees.
- ◆ 1920 : Famous sitar player Pandit Ravi Shankar was born.
- ◆ 2011 : Famous poet Janaki Vallabh Shastri passed away.

#### **Current Affairs Related to 7th April**

- has formed and launched a new platform, the Flipkart Foundation, with a focus on development in rural areas and providing equal access to development opportunities for women and other disadvantaged communities. The Flipkart Foundation aims to use the lessons of Flipkart to positively impact the lives of 20 million people, directly and indirectly, across multiple sectors in the coming decade. The operations of the Flipkart Foundation will be grant based. Contribution to this will come through the charity checkout facility available on the Flipkart group and the Flipkart platform.
- ♦ The Central Government has appointed Vinay Mohan Kwatra as the next Foreign Secretary of India. Kwatra is the Ambassador of India to Nepal. He will take over as Foreign Secretary in place of Harsh Vardhan Chain. At the same time, Varshavardhan Series is retiring on 30 April. Vinay Mohan Kwatra's image is considered very good in matters of foreign diplomacy. It is clear from his appointment that the Indian Ministry of External Affairs has unwavering faith in Vinay Mohan Kwatra. After making him ambassador to Nepal, the central government has decided to entrust him with a very important responsibility once again.
- ♦ Indian astronomers in collaboration with their French counterpart have discovered a new faint galaxy. This research is published in the journal Astronomy and Astrophysics. This galaxy could not be detected properly because it was present in front of a very bright galaxy.
- ♦ UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres appointed Arunabha Ghosh to a non-state high-level special group. Arunabha Ghosh is the CEO of the Council for Energy, Environment and Water, a climate and energy think tank. He has been appointed to T20 Finance Track Advisory Group of the Government of India for G20 Presidency of India in 2023. In 2021, he was appointed as the G20 2022 of Indonesia's T20 Task Force on Climate and Energy for 2022.

- Around 60 Artificial Intelligence-based cameras will be installed around the city of Kozhikode in Kerala as a part of the state-level road safety project. The move will be implemented with an aim to uncover traffic rules violations and book them with solid digital evidence. There will be 726 cameras attached to special control rooms of enforcement squads across the state. The state government will spend Rs 225 crore on this project.
- ♦ The United Nations Human Rights Council has appointed Dr. Ian Fry the world's first independent expert on human rights and climate change. Dr. Fry has been appointed for a term of three years. He holds dual citizenship of Tuvalu and Australia. The first to take over will be Ian Fry, who holds both Australian and Tuvaluan nationalities.
- The Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, in a written reply in Rajya Sabha, informed about the various initiatives taken by the Government for adoption of technology in agriculture. In the year 2021, a consultation paper on India Digital Ecosystem of Agriculture was released by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare which talks about digital revolution in the agriculture sector.
- The Supreme Court struck down the 10.5 percent internal reservation for the Vanniyakula Kshatriya community in Tamil Nadu. The Supreme Court held that the 10.5% internal reservation to the Vanniyakula Kshatriya community violates the fundamental rights of equality, non-discrimination and equal opportunity of 115 other most backward communities and denotified communities in Tamil Nadu.
- The Indian President visited Turkmenistan for the first time where he signed four agreements including financial, intelligence and disaster management and agreed to expand bilateral trade and energy cooperation to further strengthen the multi-faceted partnership. Earlier a Memorandum of Understanding was signed between India and Turkmenistan on cooperation in the field of disaster management.




