History of June 7

- ♦ 1539: In the battle of Chausa near Buxar, Afghan Sher Shah Suri defeated the Mughal emperor Humayun.
- ♦ 1893 : Mahatma Gandhi used civil disobedience for the first time in South Africa.
- ♦ 1979: India's second satellite Bhaskar-I was launched from Bears Lake, Soviet Union.
- ◆ 2006 : India decided to give one billion rupees to

 Nepal for economic reconstruction.

Current Affairs Related to 7 June

- Air Force Heritage Center will be set up in Chandigarh. A heritage center will be set up in Chandigarh to showcase the role of the Indian Air Force in various wars and its overall functioning. The IAF Heritage Center will be set up jointly by the force and the Chandigarh Administration. A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the Union Territory of Chandigarh and the Indian Air Force for the establishment of the Centre. Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit and Air Chief Marshal VR Choudhary were present at the ceremony.
- ♦ Country's first Liquid Mirror Telescope arrived in Uttarakhand. The first Liquid Mirror Telescope in the country—and the largest in Asia—was commissioned atop a hilltop shrine in Uttarakhand. It will now monitor the overhead sky to identify transient or variable objects such as supernovae, gravitational lenses, space debris and asteroids. The Indian Liquid Mirror Telescope will help survey the sky, making it possible to observe many galaxies and other astronomical sources, which simply stare at the strip of sky passing above.
- Organization inaugurated the spacecraft manufacturing unit of Anantha Technologies at Industrial Area Development Board Aerospace Park. The new state-of-the-art spacecraft manufacturing facility can conduct the assembly and testing of up to four large spacecraft simultaneously. This is the first facility of its kind in India. Since its inception in 1992, Anant Technologies has contributed to the manufacturing of 89 satellites and 69 launch vehicles built/launched by ISRO.
- Freedom fighter Anjalai Ponnusamy who fought for India's independence from colonial Britain passed away at the age of 102. At the age of 21, Anjalai joined the Rani Regiment of Jhansi, a women's regiment of the Indian National Army, hoping to remove the yoke of British colonialism from the Indian people.

- The residential education scheme Shrestha has been launched for the high school students of the targeted areas. It has been launched by the Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment Dr. Virendra Kumar. This scheme will prove to be very beneficial for the Scheduled Caste students who have not yet had access to high quality education. The Social Justice and Empowerment Department will bear the total expenditure of school fees and hostel fees till the completion of their education up to class 12th.
- Javier Olivan will take over as the company's chief operating officer following the stepping down of Sheryl Sandberg, the current Chief Development Officer of Meta Platforms. Olivan has been with Meta for several years, formerly known as Facebook, contributing to its explosive expansion. Olivan will be responsible for advertising and business products while continuing to drive infrastructure and corporate growth.
- ◆ Harini Logan was initially dropped from the Scripps National Spelling Bee, but was later relegated to the competition. She missed four words in a fierce fight against Vikram Raju, including a word that could have won her the title. Harini finally clinched the title in the first Kard tiebreaker match.
- ◆ Ashwani Bhatia has taken charge as a whole-time member in the markets regulator Securities and Exchange Board of India. Bhatia was earlier the managing director of state-owned State Bank of India. SEBI now has three WTMs after Bhatia's induction.
- Santoor player and Padyashree awardee Bhajan Sopori has passed away at the age of 73. The santoor player was born in 1948 in Sopore, Kashmir Valley and belonged to the Sufiana gharana of Indian classical music. He was the great-grandson of Pandit Shankar Pandit, who developed the style popularly known as Sufi Baaz, based on Sufiana Kalam and Hindustani classical music.


