History of June 8

- ◆ **1658** : Aurangzeb captured the fort of Agra.
- ◆ **1936** : The government radio network of India was renamed **All India Radio**.
- ◆ **1557** : **England** declared war on France.
- ◆ **1948** : India's first airline **Air India** started air service between **India and Britain**.
- ◆ **1998** : Honda had to pay **\$17.1 million** for the removal of non-polluting equipment in 1.6 million cars.

Current Affairs Related to 8 June

- ◆ **Tata Projects will take on** the Shapoorji Pallonji Group and Larsen & Toubro for the contract to build the new airport in the National Capital Region at Jewar. Though the size of the deal has not been disclosed, sources put it at over Rs 6,000 crore. Tata Projects, the infrastructure and construction arm of the Tata Group, will construct terminals, runways, airside infrastructure, roads, utilities, landside facilities and other ancillary buildings at Noida International Airport.
- ◆ **NBFC giant, HDFC has announced a collaboration with global information technology services and consulting firm, Accenture, to digitally transform its lending business.** This tie-up will improve HDFC's customer experience and business processes to deliver greater operational efficiencies and accelerate business growth. It leverages a machine learning based decision engine that aims to improve risk mitigation and driving agility by standardizing the credit underwriting process.
- ◆ **Following the guidelines of the Central Government advising against the use of the word Harijan,** the Delhi government is set to replace the word Harijan in the names of colonies and streets after Babasaheb Ambedkar. In this sequence, Social Welfare Minister Rajendra Pal Gautam has proposed to change the name of all the roads and colonies of Delhi Government from Harijan to Dr. Ambedkar.
- ◆ **Meghalaya Enterprise Architect, part of Meghalaya Enterprise Architect's flagship initiative of the Meghalaya government's e-offer system, has won a prestigious UN Award-World Summit on the Information Society Forum award in Geneva, Switzerland.** Houlin Zhao, General Secretary of ITU, presented the winning award to Chief Minister Konrad K Sangma at the WSIS Forum Awards 2022 held in Geneva, Switzerland.
- ◆ **Indo-Bangladesh Bilateral Defense Cooperation,** a joint military training exercise Ex SAMPRITI-X is being conducted from June 5 to June 16, 2022 at Jashore Military Station in Bangladesh.
- ◆ **Dr. GR Chintala, President, National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development has launched My Pad My Right program in Leh.** The program is started by the NABARD Foundation of NABARD with machinery and material worth Rs.7.5 lakhs. Dr. GR Chintala announced sanction of one lakh more to upgrade the machinery for making sanitary pads to suit the demands of women of different age groups. This will help women to participate in the economic development of the country. Under this unique project, award-winning sanitary pad manufacturing machines will be installed through a network of SHGs.
- ◆ **Chhattisgarh has become the second state in the country to recognize the community forest resource rights of a village within the Kanger Ghati National Park.** While community forest resource rights are important empowerment tools, it often proves to be a challenge to achieve consensus among different villages about their traditional boundaries.
- ◆ **The government has approved an interest rate of 8.1 per cent on Employees' Provident Fund deposits for 2021-22,** the lowest level in more than four decades for nearly five crore subscribers of retirement fund body Employees' Provident Fund Organisation. Earlier in March this year, EPFO had decided to reduce the interest on provident fund deposits for 2021-22 from 8.5 per cent provided in 2020.21 to 8.1 per cent.
- ◆ **The 2022 French Open was a Grand Slam tennis tournament played on outdoor clay courts.** The tournament was held at the Stade Roland Garros in Paris, France, consisting of singles, doubles and mixed doubles games. Inga Swetec won the women's singles event, securing his second French Open crown, and Rafael Nadal won the men's singles event, capturing his record-expanding 14th French Open title.
