#### **History of June 9**

- 1659: Jeevan Khan, the Baluchi chief of Dadar, fraudulently handed over the Mughal prince Dara Shikoh to Aurangzeb.
- ◆ 2008: The Union Territory Administration declared Chandigarh tobacco free.
- ♦ 1949 : India's first woman IPS Kiran Bedi was born.
- ♦ 1964: Lal Bahadur Shastri became the second Prime Minister of India.
- ♦ 1900 : Tribal leader and Lok Nayak Birsa Munda died

#### **Current Affairs Related to 9 June**

- The digital payments market in India is expected to grow three-fold from the current \$3 trillion to \$10 trillion in the next four years (by 2026). This was confirmed by a report released by PhonePe in collaboration with Boston Consulting Group (BCG), titled Digital Payments in India: A \$10 Trillion Opportunity. The report highlights the evolution of India's digital payments over the past five years. Those digital payments will aim to constitute two out of three payment transactions by 2026 as a result of growth over five years.
- ↑ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin flagged off the luxury cruise liner Empress from Chennai port. The eleven-storey tourist ship can accommodate two thousand passengers and about 800 crew members. The package also includes departure from the city port to the high seas and back, and anchorage at Puducherry and Visakhapatnam ports, as stated by the operator. There are two, three and five days in three different packages.
- The Reserve Bank of India launched its first global hackathon, Harbiser 2021 for Innovation for Transformation, the theme of which was Smart Digital Payments, which was communicated. The hackathon received an encouraging response with 363 proposals submitted by teams from within India and from 22 other countries including USA, UK, Sweden, Singapore, Philippines and Israel. The hackathon ran in three phases with the shortlisting of proposals in the first phase, solution development in the second phase and the final evaluation in the third phase.
- ♦ President Ram Nath Kovind paid tributes to Sant Kabir and inaugurated Sant Kabir Academy and Research Center and Swadesh Darshan Scheme at Kabir Chaura Dham, Maghar, Uttar Pradesh. He said that Kabir's life embodies human qualities and his teachings are relevant even today after 650 years. He described Kabir's life as a perfect example of communal unity.

- Punjab and Himachal Pradesh will ban single-use plastic from July 1.
- In Raxaul, Bihar, the Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare and Chemicals and Fertilizers Mansukh Mandaviya inaugurated the National Food Laboratory of FSSAI in Raxaul, Bihar. Under the bilateral agreement between India and Nepal, this laboratory was established in Raxaul from Nepal to reduce the time taken in testing the samples of imported food items. Testing of food was time consuming as food samples were sent to the National Food Laboratory in Kolkata with legal discretion.
- Swaroop Kumar Saha of the government has been appointed as the head of Punjab and Sind Bank. Saha, who is the executive director of Punjab National Bank, replaced S Krishnan who retired on May 31. A Bachelor of Science from the University of Calcutta, Kolkata, Saha started his career in banking as a Probationary Officer in the then Oriental Bank of Commerce in the year 1990.
- Dutch documentary film Turn Your Body to the Sun tells the incredible story of a Soviet prisoner. It has won the prestigious Golden Conch Award for Best Documentary Film at MIFF 2022. Directed by Aliona van der Horst, Turn Your Body to the Sun brings to light the incredible life story of a Soviet soldier of Tatar descent who is captured by the Nazis during World War II.
- ♦ Mahendra Singh Dhoni has been appointed as the brand ambassador of Garud Aerospace.
- ♦ An agreement has been signed between India and Israel on the Vision Statement.
- ♦ ISRO Chairman S Somanath has inaugurated the new spacecraft manufacturing facility at the Karnataka Industrial Area Development Board Aerospace Park.
- ◆ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has started the Lifestyle for the Environment movement.


